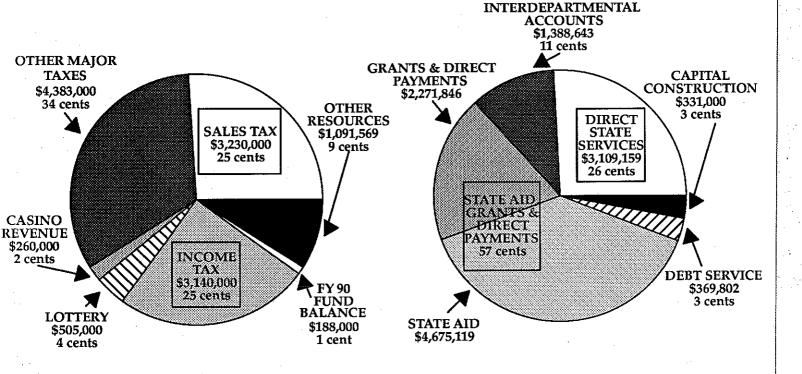

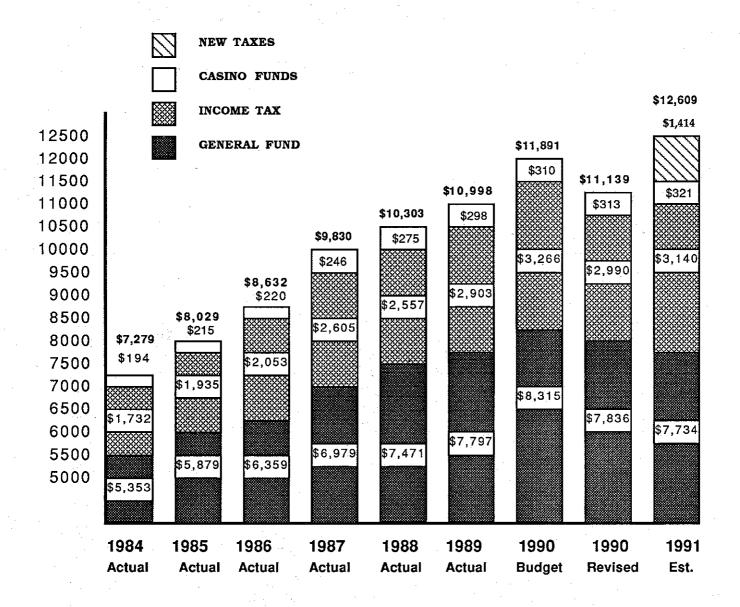

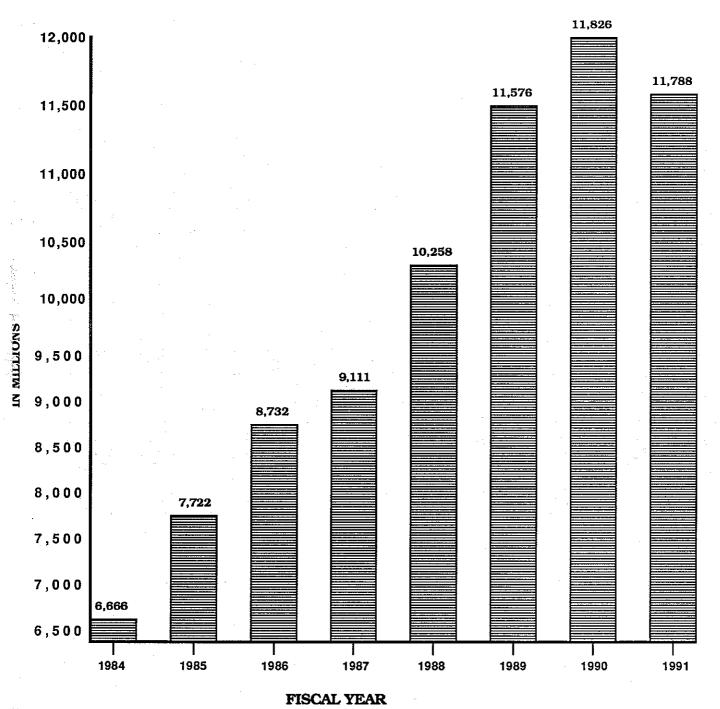


NEW JERSEY STATE BUDGET TOTAL STATE APPROPRIATIONS
