LANGUAGE PROVISIONS

It is recommended that notwithstanding the provisions of P.L. 1954, c. 48(C. 52:34–6 et seq.), the Department of Environmental Protection may enter into a contract with the Waterloo Foundation for the Arts for improvements to existing State—owned structures or for the construction of new facilities at Waterloo Village.

LANGUAGE PROVISIONS

It is recommended that receipts representing the State share from the rental or lease of property, and the unexpended balances as of June 30, 1990 of such receipts, be appropriated for maintenance or improvement of transportation property, equipment and facilities.

It is further recommended that in addition to the amount hereinabove for State Highway Facilities, such other sums as the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting shall determine, provided in interdepartmental accounts for employee benefits, be considered as appropriated on behalf of State Highway Construction and Transportation Construction Engineering and be available for matching Federal funds.

It is further recommended that the sum provided hereinabove for the Transportation Trust Fund accounts shall be provided from revenues received from motor fuel taxes pursuant to Article VIII, Section 2, paragraph 4 of the State Constitution, P.L. 1984, c. 73 and R.S.54:39–27 as amended by P.L. 1987, c. 460, from increases in fees charged for commercial motor vehicles, and be provided from funds received or receivable from the various transportation oriented authorities.

It is further recommended that notwithstanding the provisions of P.L. 1984, c. 73(C27:1b-4) as amended by P.L. 1987, c. 460, there be allocated from the amount hereinabove such amounts, not to exceed \$25,000,000, as the Commissioner of Transportation shall determine, with the approval of the Director of Budget and Accounting, for personal services by contract or in lieu thereof, by State employees for planning, engineering, design, research, construction, right-of-way acquisition, or other costs, directly related to projects in the New Jersey transportation construction program, and approved revisions and supplements thereto.

It is recommended that funds derived from the sale of any lands and buildings or proceeds from the sale of all fill material held by a department be appropriated for demolition, acquisition of land, rehabilitation or improvement of existing facilities and construction of new facilities for use by that department, subject to the approval of the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting.

It is further recommended that the unexpended balances as of June 30, 1990 in the Capital Construction accounts be appropriated, subject to the approval of the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting.
