Thankfully, there is a nonprofit organization that builds and repairs houses all over the world using volunteer labor and donations. Please Join the New Jersey FFA Association in the 2014 Statewide Community Service Project – Habitat for Humanity Fundraiser!

The New Jersey FFA Association is joining the movement to provide homes to everyone in need of a place to live for them and their families. Take up the cause by sponsoring “bricks” to build homes! Not actual bricks, of course, but graphics of bricks to be sold at \$1.00. Each graphic should include the name of the sponsor and be displayed with every other brick sold in your classroom or hallway as a mural. Grow your collection and document it with plenty of photos. Email a photo of your mural to ag.ed.registration@ag.state.nj.us by May 16, 2014. The chapter with the most bricks sold will have their mural displayed on screen at the 85th New Jersey State FFA Convention!

Chapter donations will be collected on Tuesday, May 21, 2014 between 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm at the judges' registration table in Pollak Theatre. All chapters who contribute will be recognized by the State Officers during the 2nd General Session of the 85th NJ State FFA Convention.

How to Participate in FFA Habitat for Humanity:

1. Print out bricks as needed. (Cardstock works best.)
2. Cut out the bricks.
3. Sell the brick for \$1.
4. Encourage supporters to sign their name and/or write a short message on the brick.
5. Display the bricks in your school.
6. By May 16, email a photo of your brick mural to ag.ed.registration@ag.state.nj.us
7. On May 21 (at the State FFA Convention), submit the funds to the registration table in Pollak Theatre before the first session.
8. Be sure all funds are secure in a large envelope with the name of your chapter on the front.
9. Chapters that participate in the FFA Habitat for Humanity community service project will be recognized on stage at the State FFA Convention during the 2nd General Session.
10. Check donations should be made out to the “NJ FFA Foundation, Inc.”
