| Members attending the State FFA Convention must be aware of the following rules. A member who violates or ignores any of the below code of conduct subjects himself/herself to: 1. Being removed from the State FFA Convention and sent home at his or her expense after consultation with his/her chapter advisor(s) and a school administrator; 2. Having any honors and/or office withdrawn. We expect the cooperation of every member. Students shall behave in a courteous and respectful manner, refraining from language and actions that might bring discredit upon the FFA. Students shall participate fully in all appropriate convention activities, general sessions, workshops, business meetings, meals, etc. Students shall wear official FFA dress (or business dress) correctly at all convention sessions and events. Official dress is: An official FFA jacket zipped to the top; black slacks and black socks/nylons or black skirt and black nylons; white collared blouse or white collared shirt; official FFA tie or official FFA scarf; black dress shoes with closed heel and toe. Attire for other portions of convention (i.e. the dance) should be in good taste and in line with local school dress code policies. Keep in mind you are representing your school, your community and New Jersey FFA. Students shall be willing to take and follow instructions as directed by convention staff. Students shall avoid places and actions which in any way could raise questions as to moral character or conduct. Students shall and damage or deface property at the State FFA Convention. Damages to any property will be paid for by the member or his/her school. This includes missing room keys and building access cards. Students shall stay in his/her room during the convention and shall keep his/her chapter advisor(s) informed of his/her activities and whereabouts at all times.
