DAIRY CATTLE MANAGEMENT AND EVALUATION

The New Jersey FFA Association will participate in the New Jersey State 4-H Dairy Judging Event as the state qualifying event for National FFA Convention. This event will take place at Spring Run Dairy in Hunterdon County – 87 School House Road, Pittstown, NJ 08867. It is scheduled for <u>Saturday, May 3,</u> <u>2025</u>. Please register your teams with the State FFA Office no later than Tuesday, April 15th. The State office will pre-register all New Jersey teams by the deadline with the New Jersey 4-H.

Preregistration is required for participation. Please register at <u>https://form.jotform.com/NJFFA/dairycattlecde</u> by <u>April 15, 2025</u>.

SCHEDULE FOR THE DAY

Registration – 8:30 am Judge 4 classes of Cattle – 9:00 – 10:00 am Oral Reasons (two sets) – 10:00 am - Noon Comments from Judges – 12:30 pm

<u>RULES</u>

- 1. All participants must be FFA members in good standing in their respective chapter.
- 2. A team must consist of four members. Teams must be accompanied by an adult advisor/coach.
- 3. This event will be used to select the team to represent New Jersey FFA at the National FFA Convention in October. Visit the CDE & LDE Event Participation Policy Handbook for a full breakdown.
- 4. Contestants are not allowed to take any books or notes to the contest. Only clip boards and blank notepaper will be accepted.
- 5. A timekeeper will be designated; there will be a total of 12 minutes to place each class. For those classes with oral reasons, an additional 8 minutes will be allowed for taking notes on the class.
- 6. All contestants must wear rubber boots which can be disinfected, or plastic boot covers.
- 7. Official dress is not necessary. However, an FFA shirt, long pants and close-toed shoes are mandatory.
- 8. Official score cards will be provided on the day of the event and must be turned in when requested.
- 9. New Jersey 4-H's rules and scoring procedures will be followed. FFA members CAN be a part of a 4-H team at this event.

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NEW JERSEY 4-H EVENT PERMISSION FORM FOR YOUTH AND ADULT/ADVISOR

All contestants must submit a completed Permission Form <u>AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION</u>. These forms CANNOT be submitted on the day of the event. State FFA Staff must receive these forms in a timely manner so the forms can accompany the registration submitted to the State 4-H office.

PAYMENT:

The Dairy Cattle Management and Evaluation CDE fee will be \$11.00 per participant payable to **Treasurer, State of NJ.** No lunch is included in registration. *If your chapter has at least Blue Affiliation, the fee is waived.

DIRECTIONS: 87 School House Road, Pittstown, NJ 08867

From the South: Use I-295 N in Greenwich Township from NJ-45 N and Tomlin Station Road. Take exit 27 for I-295 toward Trenton/I-76/I-676/US 130. Continue onto I-295 N. Take exit 72 for NJ-31 toward Ewing/Pennington. Slight right onto the Route 31 N ramp. Merge onto NJ-31 N/Pennington Rd. Continue on NJ-31 N to your destination in Alexandria. Turn left onto School House Road. Destination will be on the left.

From the North: Take Belvidere Road to N Main Street. Turn left onto NJ-173 E. Continue onto Bloomsbury Road. Turn right onto Woolf Road. Turn left onto School House Road. Destination will be on the right.
