Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) States

As of March 16, 2017, the following U.S. state has had HPAI detected in poultry within 60 days and therefore all poultry and hatching eggs from this state moving into New Jersey live bird markets require a permit and 72 hour test:

Tennessee – last confirmed case March 16, 2017
