**1.01 PURPOSE**

The WTS2000 portable sediment tank, developed by Aqualete Industries, is used to remove suspended sediments from stormwater and is intended to comply with the requirements for portable sediment tanks under the NJ Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Standards - Standard for Dewatering.

**1.02 SUMMARY**

Aqualete has conducted several field trial applications on construction sites in New Jersey with subsequent laboratory analysis demonstrating the effectiveness of the device.

Based on field and laboratory testing results, review by District staff and the State Engineer, the WTS2000 portable sediment tank is therefore approved for use in New Jersey for compliance with the Standard for Dewatering, when used in accordance with the manufacturer's requirements for installation, use and handling and in accordance with all applicable Standards.
