Pasteurized full-strength juice may only be used to meet the vegetable or fruit requirement at one meal, including snack, per day.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>Grains Requirements: Whole Grain-Rich (WGR)- At least one serving per day, across all eating occasions, must be whole grain-rich. Breakfast cereals must contain no more than 6 grams of sugar per dry ounce (no more than 21.2 grams sucrose and other sugars per 100 grams of dry cereal). Grain-based desserts do not count towards meeting the grains requirement.

<sup>\*\*\*\*</sup>Meat Alternates Requirements: At breakfast, meat and meat alternates may be used to meet the entire grains requirement a maximum of three times a week. One ounce of meat and meat alternates is equal to one ounce equivalent of grains. Yogurt must contain no more than 23 grams of total sugars per 6 ounces. Alternate protein products must meet the requirements in Appendix A to Part 226.
