Proposed projects must benefit the wine industry as a whole and funded project activities may not exclude any plenary and/or farm wine licensee whose sales of New Jersey wine contribute to the Wine Promotion Account and who wishes to participate.

All applications must be **completed** and **received** at the address below by **May 10, 2017**. A response of the approval or disapproval of applications will be sent no later than June 12, 2017.
