### BY THE BOARD:

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") through its New Jersey Clean Energy Program ("NJCEP") includes several individual Commercial & Industrial ("C&I") Energy Efficiency ("EE") Programs targeting the commercial and industrial market segments. Eligible applicants may receive rebates for a portion of the cost for installing energy efficient technologies such as lighting, HVAC, and other energy conservation measures. Incentives are also available for projects involving Distributed Energy Resources ("DER"). All proposed C&I EE financial incentives and rebates exceeding \$500,000 require explicit Board approval. See In the Matter of the Comprehensive Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Resource Analysis for the 2009 through 2012 Clean Energy Program - Revised 2012-2013 Programs & Budgets - Revised Rebate Approval Process, BPU Docket No. E007030203 (May 3, 2013).

The Pay for Performance – Existing Buildings ("P4P – EB") Program uses a comprehensive, whole building approach to energy efficiency in existing commercial and industrial buildings or eligible multifamily facilities. Similar to performance contracting programs offered in other states, this program links incentives directly to energy savings and includes a measurement and verification component to ensure that the estimated savings levels are achieved. Incentives are released upon satisfactory completion of three milestones.

By this Order, the Board considers the application of AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center in Pomona, New Jersey, submitted on July 19, 2017 under the Fiscal Year 2018 ("FY18") P4P – EB Program pursuant to the Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Program Plan Filing for Fiscal Year 2018 dated June 28, 2017. The project is located at AtlantiCare Regional Medical

Center Mainland Campus, 65 West Jimmie Leeds Road, Pomona, New Jersey. The applicant requests a total financial incentive of \$559,338.60 for a project that will cost \$4,649,799.

This application covers chiller plant optimization, including installing new Variable Frequency Drives ("VFDs") on water pumps that allow for partial load sequencing, as well as replacing existing fluorescent lights with LED lighting. VFDs control the speed of the HVAC's equipment's motors to ensure the most efficient amount of energy is being used based on demand. The Company also wishes to install a number of HVAC upgrades, including adding Energy Recovery Ventilation to the Variable Air Volume ("VAV") HVAC system and adding VFD to the kitchen HVAC system. This application further covers reconfiguring existing Constant Volume HVAC units to more efficient VAV HVAC units with dampers and VFDs that will schedule energy usage based on the hospital's occupancy.

The estimated first incentive, to offset the cost of services for developing the energy reduction plan ("ERP"), is \$50,000. The estimated second incentive, based on projected energy savings as estimated in the approved ERP, to be paid after the installation of the recommended measures, is \$254,669.30. The estimated third incentive, which is paid upon submittal of a Post Construction Benchmarking Report that verifies the level of savings achieved, is \$254,669.30. These incentive amounts are within entity cap guidelines.

The project is estimated to save 1,485,492 kWh of electricity and 79,361 therms of natural gas annually. The proposed project will have an estimated annual energy cost savings of \$247,695. The payback period without incentives is 18.8 years; when factoring in the incentives, the payback period is reduced to 16.5 years.

TRC Environmental Corporation, the Program Manager engaged by the Board to manage the NJCEP P4P – EB program, attested to the accuracy of certain information regarding the project and that the project application adheres to the current terms and conditions of the program. Further, TRC, in its role as the NJCEP Program Administrator, submitted its certification that the incentives were calculated in accordance with the program's policies and procedures, the listed amounts are the true and accurate estimated incentives for which the applicant is eligible, and the documentation supporting estimated energy savings inputs was located, reviewed, and made available to calculate the rebate amounts as required by the program's policies and procedures. Based on these certifications and the information provided by the Program Manager and Program Administrator, Board Staff recommends approval of the above-referenced application.

The Board <u>HEREBY ORDERS</u> the approval of the aforementioned application for the total estimated incentive amount of \$559,338.60 for AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center and <u>AUTHORIZES</u> issuance of a standard commitment letter to the applicant identified above, setting forth the terms and conditions of this commitment.
