BY THE BOARD:

On November 13, 2007, Atlantic City Sewerage Company (Petitioner or Company), a public utility of the State of New Jersey subject to the jurisdiction of the Board of Public Utilities (Board), and providing wastewater service to approximately 7,500 customers within its defined territory consisting of the City of Atlantic City, Atlantic County, New Jersey, filed a petition for a revision of its Purchased Sewerage Treatment Adjustment Clause (PSTAC) from its current \$19.912 per Mcf of metered water to a rate of \$20.823 per Mcf of metered water or \$.911 per Mcf or 4.56%. The Company proposed to make the rates effective on and after December 14, 2007.


For the base tariff rates for wastewater service, the Company proposes to increase wastewater rates in the overall amount of \$2,737,038 or 15.6% which includes the Company's proposed PSTAC increase.

The matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing. On November 28, 2007, the Board suspended the proposed increase in rates until April 14, 2008, pending a determination on the hearing on the justness and reasonableness of Petitioner's proposed rates.


In light of the fact that this proceeding is pending before the Office of Administrative Law, the Board HEREBY ORDERS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-21, that the proposed revisions in rates be and are HEREBY FURTHER SUSPENDED until August 14, 2008, unless the Board prior to that date makes a determination disposing of the petition.




