TELECOM REPAIR FOR THE MERCER COUNTY COOPERATIVE CONTRACT PURCHASING SYSTEM

SCOPE OF WORK

The County of Mercer requests bids based upon time and materials for telecom work to be performed at any existing County facility and any proposed and/or new County facility. Work shall be issued to the Contractor through sequential work orders for each separate project. THE AWARDED CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE LABOR AND PARTS AS DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE COUNTY. The county expended approximately \$50,000.00 on installations and repair in 2008. The County has budgeted \$25,000.00 in 2009 for this services. Bidders shall provide staffing to accommodate the requirements of the County and Coop members if extended to the Mercer County Coop.

The contract shall be awarded based upon the hourly rate for normal working hours between 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM and parts shall be reimbursed at twenty percent (20%) above the wholesale cost to the vendor. All work shall be warranted for a period of one year. Vendors shall have three years experience working on projects of similar scope and shall provide two references.

COOPERATIVE CONTRACT PURCHASING

With the approval of both Mercer County and the vendor, contracting units located within the geographic boundary of Mercer County may purchase under the contract subject to its specifications, terms and conditions. Bidders shall provide staffing adequate to accommodate the requirements of the County and Coop members if extended to the coop. Refer to page 36 for a listing of all coop members.

The Level 1 Telecom Technician shall provide the following Telecom Services:

- Wiring of RJ11 & RJ45 Type Jacks
- EIA/TIA 568A & B type wiring
- Frame Wiring
- X-Connect Wiring
- 66 Block Terminations
- 110 Block Terminations
- Tone and continuity testing of Cable

Telecom vendors must have experience in providing maintenance on Centrex Service Systems, POTS, Digital Trunk, Analog Trunk and PBX Lines. Vendors shall diagnose and trace line troubles, read a wiring frame for PBX to COT terminations and perform moves, adds and changes on PBX and Centrex Lines.

Contractor must provide the following for each project:

Proposal for each job request based upon proposal labor rate which shall be forwarded to the Director of Information Technology for review and approval.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Awarded contractor must provide site clean-up, job walkthrough for acceptance and creation of "Punch List", scheduling and implementation of punch list items, final walk through for Acceptance/Sign-off and Billing in accordance with proposed hourly rate and mark-up. Vendors shall provide a markup on wholesale pricing and shall provide proof of wholesale pricing.

RESPONSE TIME

The awarded contractor shall provide a proposal for requested work within one week from notification by the county designee. The contractor must respond to emergency repair calls as requested through The Director of Information Technology and arrive on the site within four (4) hours after notification between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:30 P.M. Monday through Friday. If the awarded contractor fails to arrive on site within four hours; the third incident shall be cause for termination of the contract.

PREVAILING WAGE

VENDORS MUST COMPLY WITH THE NEW JERSEY PREVAILING WAGE ACT AND MUST BE REGISTERED AT THE TIME OF THE BID SUBMITTAL AS A NEW JERSEY PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTOR.

For work involving telephone cabling in existing buildings, if there are 15 or fewer drops involved (a drop is a line or jack), the "Electrician-Teledata" rate can be used. If there are more than 15 drops in an existing building, or if the work is part of a new Construction project (including new additions to existing buildings), the "Electrician" rate must be used.

CONTRACT PERIOD

Six months with option to extend one year as the county may migrate from Centrex to VoIP.

PRICING

The hourly rate provided by bidders shall include full compensation including furnishing all labor, materials, tools and equipment for performing all the work involved in repair and installation as specified herein.

NOTE: The County shall determine which work will be forwarded to the contractor. The County shall be the sole judge of work to be completed by County forces and the County reserves the right to reject the contractor's estimates and perform the work with the County's own forces.

EXPERIENCE, REFERENCES AND BACKGROUND CHECK

Vendors must have a minimum three years experience and provide three references. Vendor must provide a background check for each employee assigned to this contract. Results of the background check shall be forwarded to the Director of Information Technology.

STAFFING

Bidders shall provide the names of employees assigned to this contract.
