**Subject: Mercer County Wastewater Management Plan
Invitation – 1st Working Meeting
Corporate/Educational/Health Care Campus Requirements**

A few weeks ago a letter introducing the planning process for the county-wide Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) was sent to you. As a follow-up to that letter, you are invited to attend the first working meeting on April 30, 2009, 3:00 pm to 4:30 pm, Room 211 in the McDade Administration Building, 640 South Broad Street, Trenton, New Jersey.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss and work on initial data requirements and issues arising from the new Rules.

Prior to the meeting, I am asking that you begin to gather data that may be relevant to the development of the WMP. The summary below prepared by Camp Dresser McKee (CDM), the county's consultant on the project, provides an explanation of these initial data needs.

Your participation in the first phase of data development is critical to the completion of the WMP and in meeting our goal to have a draft WMP completed by September 2009.

In addition to the April 30th meeting, it may be necessary for CDM to contact you in the near future to set up a meeting for the clarification and/or exchange of data. WMP Data Requirements and Needs


Mercer County is in the process of developing a Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) that will meet the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's (NJDEP) Water Quality Management Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-1.1 et seq.) revised as of July 7, 2008. The County's role as the responsible agency includes preparing, submitting, and updating the WMP, as well as commenting on amendments and revisions to WMPs.

Corporate, educational, and health care campuses exist throughout Mercer County. The County is aware that these locations may expand, develop, and change in the future. While the Rules do not currently include specific requirements regarding such items as General Development Plans (GDPs), Mercer County is looking to collect any relevant available information including, but not limited to:

1. Any agreements or Planning Board Approvals allowing additional flow to existing sewer systems
2. Maps showing the existing conditions of a General Development area including connections to the sewer collection system and water supply system
3. Maps showing possible future conditions of a General Development area including possible connections to the sewer collection system and water supply system
4. Any documents including an explanation of plans for expansion (or downsizing) of a General Development area

Most of the WMP analysis performed by the County and its consultant will be done through geographical information systems (GIS). Therefore, it would be a great help if you could submit any data as an ESRI shapefile or AutoCAD .dwg file when possible. This will help eliminate inaccuracies associated with redrawing maps provided in a different format.
