Daniel Vogdes appeals the determination of the Division of Selection Services (Selection Services) that he did not meet the experience requirement for the promotional examination for Senior Repairer (PS6888I), Department of Corrections.

The promotional examination was announced with specific requirements that had to be met as of the January 21, 2014 closing date (see attached). The examination was cancelled on May 22, 2014 since the appellant, the only applicant, was found ineligible for the examination.

A review of the appellant's application reveals that he served as a provisional Senior Repairer from November 2013 to the closing date of the application, and as a Repairer from June 2012 to October 2013. Selection Services credited the appellant with one year and eight months of experience for that work. Accordingly, Selection Services determined that the appellant lacked four months of applicable experience in work involving the inspection, repair and general maintenance of household, office and other equipment, fixtures, fittings, appliances, machinery, furnishings, and buildings.

On appeal, the appellant argues, among other things, that he is qualified for the examination, and that he continues to serve as a provisional Senior Repairer.

Official personnel records indicate that the appellant continues to serve provisionally in the subject title.

### CONCLUSION

N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) provides that applicants shall meet all requirements specified in the announcement by the closing date. N.J.A.C. 4A:1-1.2(c) provides that a rule may be relaxed for good cause in a particular situation.

Initially, it is noted that Selection Services correctly determined that the appellant was ineligible for the subject examination since he lacked four months of applicable experience. However, the record reflects that the appellant continues to serve provisionally in the title of Senior Repairer after the closing date and the examination was cancelled due to lack of qualified eligibles. Under these circumstances, good cause exists to relax the provisions of N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a) and accept the totality of the appellant's experience, including his provisional experience after the closing date, for eligibility purposes only, and admit him to the examination.

## ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this appeal be granted, the cancellation of the examination be rescinded and the appellant's application be processed for prospective employment opportunities only.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.

#### Repairer

Experience: Two (2) years of experience in work involving the inspection, repair and general maintenance of household, office and other equipment, fixtures, fittings, appliances, machinery, furnishings, and buildings.

License: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

Note: Appointees may be required to possess a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and applicable endorsements for the class and type of vehicle being operated. Proof of the license must be submitted to the appointing authority prior to appointment.

The responsibility for ensuring that employees possess the required motor vehicle license, commensurate with the class and type of vehicles they operate, rests with the appointing authority.

NOTE: As of December 1, 2013, applications must be completed and submitted by 4:00 pm on the closing date.
