Examination Appeal

David Iavarone appeals the determination of the Division of Selection Services (Selection Services) that he did not meet the experience requirement for the promotional examination for Senior Custodian (PM1973R), Jersey City School District.

The promotional examination was announced with specific requirements that had to be met as of the November 21, 2013 closing date (see attached). A total of nine employees applied for the subject examination that resulted in a list of two eligibles with an expiration date of March 26, 2017. It is noted that both of the eligibles have been permanently appointed from the list.

A review of the appellant's application indicates that he served as a Boiler Operator from November 2009 to November 2013, as an "Acting" Head Custodian from July 2011 to April 2012, and as a Custodian from February 1994 to November 2009. Official personnel records indicate that the appellant served as a Custodial Worker from February 1994 through June 1994, and from April 1995 through September 2010. Records also indicate that the appellant has been serving as a Boiler Operator since September 2010. Selection Services credited the appellant with nineteen years and ten months of applicable general experience for that work. However, Selection Services could not credit the appellant with any applicable supervisory experience as it was considered out-of-title work. Accordingly, Selection Services determined that the appellant lacked one year of applicable supervisory experience.

On appeal, the appellant argues, among other things, that he has performed supervisory duties while serving as a Boiler Operator and as a Custodial Worker. The appellant also submits a letter from his supervisor, Tony Mohamed, Maintenance Supervisor, indicating that the appellant has over five years of supervisory experience and is qualified for the examination.

CONCLUSION

N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(a)2 provides that applicants shall meet all requirements specified in the promotional announcement by the closing date. N.J.A.C. 4A:4-2.6(c) provides that, except when permitted for good cause, applicants for promotional examinations with open-competitive requirements may not use experience gained as a result of out-of-title work to satisfy the requirements for admittance to the examination or for credit in the examination process.

Initially, it is noted that Selection Services correctly credited the appellant with nineteen years and ten months of applicable general experience for his work as a Boiler Operator and as a Custodian. However, it could not credit him with any applicable supervisory experience since it was considered out-of-title work. The appellant argues on appeal that he is qualified for the examination and he possesses over five years of applicable supervisory experience. The appellant's supervisor verifies that the appellant performed supervisory duties while serving as a Custodial Worker and as a Boiler Operator. Based on the information provided by the appellant and his supervisor on appeal, the appellant has documented that he has performed the applicable supervisory duties required for the Senior Custodian examination, albeit out-of-title, for over five years. Moreover, the list has been exhausted as both eligibles have been permanently appointed. Accordingly, good cause exists to accept the appellant's out-of-title work experience, for eligibility purposes only, and admit him to the examination.

ORDER

Therefore, it is ordered that this appeal be granted and the appellant's application be processed for prospective employment opportunities only.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in a judicial forum.

Experience: Two (2) years of experience in work involving the heating, inspection, cleaning, and maintenance of furniture, fixtures, offices, buildings, and in the reconditioning, care, and maintenance of grounds, one (1) year of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

License: Appointees must possess a current, valid Black Seal Boiler Operator License of the appropriate type (high or low pressure) issued by the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development. The responsibility for ensuring that employees possess the required license, commensurate with the class and type of equipment they operate, rests with the Appointing Authority.
