TITLE: RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER AND THE LOWER CAPE MAY REGIONAL BOARD OF EDUCATION

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower (the "Township") operates a Police Department within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Lower Cape May Regional Board of Education (the "Board") operates secondary schools (collectively, the "School") within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board and the Township desire to enter an agreement whereby the Township shall make a police officer available to the Board for the purposes of providing security at the School upon the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Interlocal agreement (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is authorized by *N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Lower, in the County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the Lower Cape May Regional School District, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

## INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Agreement") dated this 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2002 by and between The LOWER CAPE MAY REGIONAL BOARD OF EDUCATION, a duly authorized New Jersey school district (hereinafter referred to as "Lower Cape May Regional School District") and THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER, a duly authorized New Jersey municipality (hereinafter referred to as "Township").

1. **Background of Agreement and Term:** Lower Cape May Regional School District operates secondary schools within Lower Township, Cape May County, New Jersey (the "Schools"). Lower Cape May Regional School District and Township have agreed to have one (1) police officer assigned to the Schools on a full-time basis commencing at the beginning of the 2001-2002 school year and ending at the end of the first half of the 2004-2005 school year (the "Term"), and the purpose of this Agreement is to set forth the parties' understanding of the Agreement.

2. **Assignment of Officer:** Township will assign one (1) full-time police officer to Lower Cape May Regional School District during the Term, with such officer to be assigned to the school on a full-time basis.

3. **Selection of Officer:** The one (1) officer to be assigned shall have a minimum of three (3) years experience. The officer shall be jointly selected by the Superintendent of Lower Cape May Regional School District ("Superintendent") and the Township Police Chief ("Chief of Police").

4. **Payment:** Lower Cape May Regional School District shall pay to Township the total sum of \$94,500.00 for such services, to be allocated and paid as follows:

(a) The sum of \$30,000.00 for the 2001-2002 school year and the first half of the 2002-2003 school year to be paid as follows:

- (i) \$15,000.00 on or before June 30, 2002;
- (ii) \$15,000.00 on or before December 31, 2002.

(b) The sum of \$31,500.00 for the second half of the 2002-2003 school year and the first half of the 2003-2004 school year to be paid as follows:

- (i) \$15,750.00 on or before June 30, 2003;
- (ii) \$15,750.00 on or before December 31, 2003.

(c) The sum of \$33,000.00 for the second half of the 2003-2004 school year and the first half of the 2004-2005 school year to be paid as follows:
