RE: Provisional Certification Expiration Date

This letter is a reminder that your provisional special inspector certification(s) will no longer be valid after June 30, 2009.

No further applications for provisional certifications will be considered after the date of this letter, nor will any extensions to existing provisional certifications be granted.

Accordingly, you must cease any and all activity that requires a special inspector certification as of June 30, 2009, unless you've met all the requirements to remove such provisional status and have received a full and regular certification for the work you are inspecting.

If you simultaneously hold both provisional and regular certifications, the regular certifications are unaffected by this notice or the expiration of provisional certifications.

If you have not met all the requirements necessary to remove your provisional status by June 30, 2009, your application will be considered an incomplete application for a regular certification.

Note that you have 18 months to complete the requirements from the date of your original "letter of acknowledgement" without the need to make a new application; however, you can **not** continue to make any special inspection after June 30, 2009 without a full and regular certification. This includes projects that are underway.
