



“Terrorism Awareness & Prevention for Fire and Emergency Medical Services” Train-the-Trainer

The New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness will be presenting a five (5) hour Train-the-Trainer program for “**CERTIFIED Fire and EMS Instructors,**” on the “**Terrorism Awareness & Prevention for Fire and Emergency Medical Services**” course. This course is approved by the U. S. Department of Homeland Security and is designed to provide situational awareness to the Fire and Emergency Medical Services community of New Jersey. This course will provide a foundation for identifying the signs of terrorism and the important role of the first responder in preventing a future terrorist attack by passing on information that may have a connection to terrorist activity. The course will provide the fire fighter and Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) with training resources on specific behaviors that may indicate terrorist activity and how to report the information.

Upon completing this training, Fire and Emergency Medical Services Instructors will be provided with training resources to facilitate an awareness level training program for their personnel. Fire Instructors will receive 0.5 CEUs for attending this course. EMT Instructors will receive 3 elective CEUs for successful completion of this course.

It’s noteworthy that these Train-the-Trainer sessions will be open to Fire and EMT Instructors ONLY and given on the dates and locations listed below. Training will start at 9:00 a.m. and end at 3:00 p.m. The training will be conducted at the following locations:

- Type Assigned Password
- Click on "Course Catalog"
- Click on "Catalog" to view Instructor Led Courses being Offered
- Advanced Search
 - Search for Keyword, Location, Instructor
 - Select "Online" or "Instructor Led"
 - Select "Entire Catalog" and Click on "Search"

- Enter Assigned User Name – Firefighters use (6) digit State ID Number
- Type Assigned Password
- Click on "Fire Personnel" Button
 - (Not hit "Enter" key)
