Advisory Base Flood Elevations (ABFE's) in General A zone, Coastal A zone and V zone

Across the top of the page, next to "Home," hold the cursor on "Hurricane Sandy" to see the pull down menu.

To see the zones and elevations shown on a map of a particular area,

1. Select the first item on this pull down menu, "Hurricane Sandy Advisory Base Flood Elevations (ABFE's)"

2. Click on "FEMA's Interactive ABFE Map" (the first bullet in the lefthand column under "Know Your Risk.") Not all zones will be shown immediately; the Coastal A zone is not a default selection needs to be added in by following these instructions.

3. Click on the "show contents on map" icon. It is the <u>middle</u> icon (which looks like a sheet of paper with writing on it) in the left-hand info box under "Details." This will bring up the contents list.

4. Check and click on "Advisory Base Flood Elevation Layers" under "Contents" which will provide a list of options.

5. Check "Limit of Moderate Wave Action (LiMWA)" and "Area of Moderate Wave Action (MOWA)" on this list. These are the options that must be checked to show the Coastal A zone (also known as "area of moderate wave action.") This is in addition to the other items already checked on the list.

6. Zoom in on the segment of the map that is of interest. When zooming in, you will see General A zones in light pink, Coastal A zones in tan and V zones in maroon.
