## PERMIT EXTENSION ACT

- On September 6, 2008, Governor Jon S. Corzine signed the Permit Extension Act of 2008 (P.L. 2008, Chapter 78).
- The Permit Extension Act of 2008 (PL 2008, c. 78) extended all applicable permits expired after January 1, 2007 up to December 31, 2010. The Act was modified on January 18, 2010. The Act now extends applicable permits up to June 30, 2013.

### Permits and documents extended under the Permit Extension Act

- Freshwater Wetlands Letter of Interpretations if the delineated line is accurate.
- Freshwater Wetlands General Permit #6 involving isolated wetlands that are not Waters of the US.
- All Freshwater Wetlands Transition Area Waivers.
- Waterfront Development Permits in water.

- Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permits.
- Coastal Wetland permits issued pursuant to the Wetlands Act of 1970.
- Flood Hazard Area Permits and verifications.
- Settlement agreements, ADR agreements and other written documents that authorize development approvals associated with any of the above mentioned permits.

# Criteria for extension

For all applicable permits and approvals except Waterfront development Permits in water:

- Site shall not be located within an environmentally sensitive area (ESA), PA4B or PA5. Environmentally Sensitive Barrier island PA5B is not considered an ESA.
- Site Shall not be located within an environmentally sensitive area issued pursuant to the Highlands Water Protection and Planning Act
- Site Shall not be located within the Pinelands
   Management Area excluding the growth area. Extension
   applies to sites within the growth area only.

- For Flood Hazard Area Permits:
- any permit or approval issued pursuant to the Flood Hazard Area Control Act, where work has commenced, in any phase or section of the development, on any site improvement, as defined in the Municipal Land Use Law.


# "Site Improvements"


• **Site improvements** include "Improvement such as: streets, grading, pavement, gutters, curbs, sidewalks, street lighting, shade trees, surveyor's monuments, water mains, culverts, storm sewers, sanitary sewers or other means of sewage disposal, drainage structures, erosion control and sedimentation control devices, public improvements of open space and, in the case of site plans only, other on-site improvements and landscaping."


• Waterfront Development Permits in water – automatically extended because the environmentally sensitive area designation does not extend below the mean high water line.

- New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's online reports portal. Within you will find a variety of reports that will provide you with up to the minute results from many different environmental media and subjects. In order to provide flexibility, many of these reports require the user to enter some criteria, which will result in a customized document.

- You can search for regulated sites by location, name,
   Program Interest ID, key words
- If you click on "reports by category", then "Permitting Dashboard", then "Access Environmental Permitting Dashboard", then scroll down to "Land Use Dashboard Reports" and click on the year, then select the choices under the given year for a particular month to access the "Land Use Dashboard Report" for that month.
