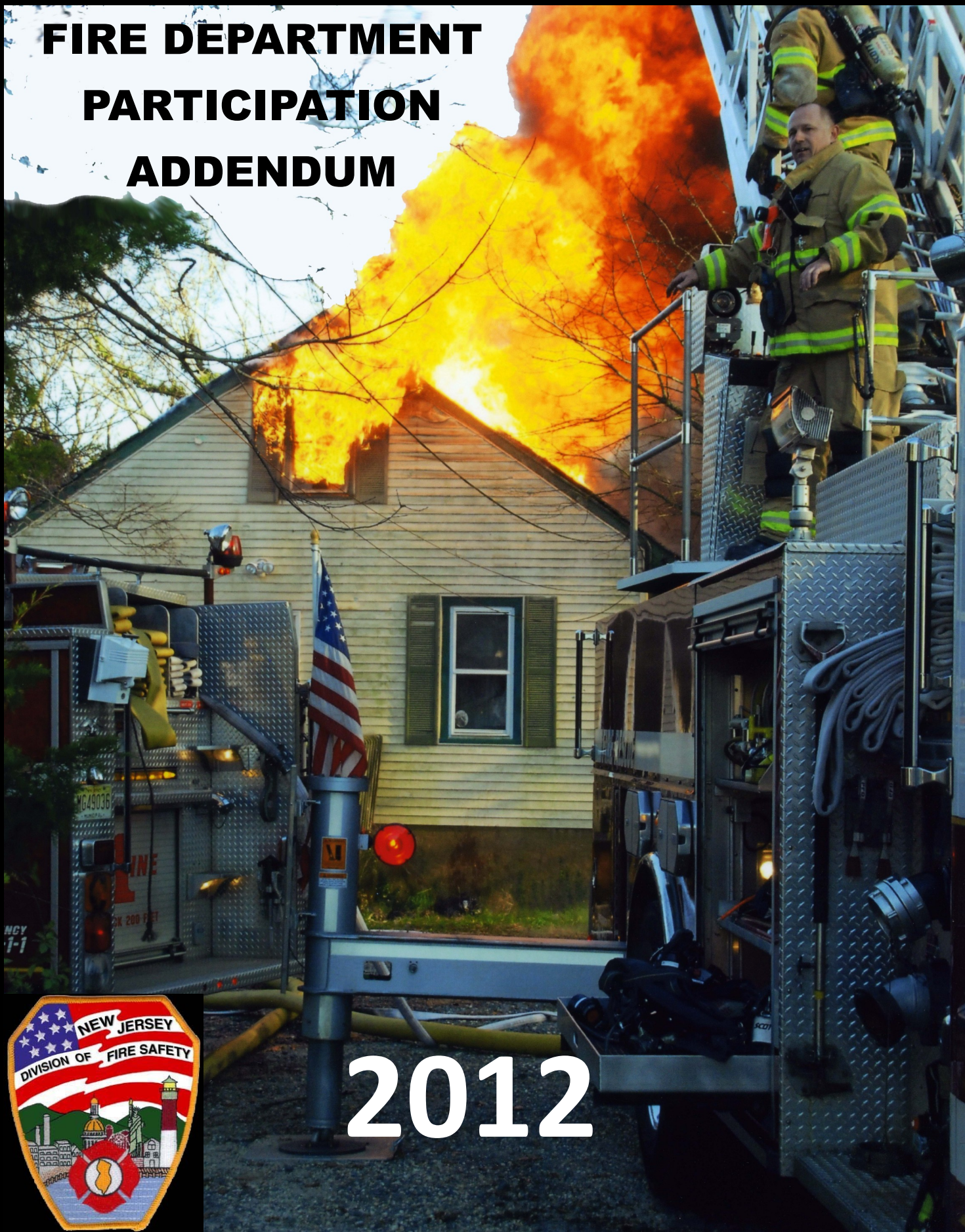

FIRE DEPARTMENT PARTICIPATION ADDENDUM 2012

The charts on the following pages show fire department participation in NFIRS data submission to the Division of Fire Safety by **June 4, 2013**.

The “Fire Department Participation” charts in this report show fire department participation in NFIRS data submission, from 2010 to 2012, received by the Division of Fire Safety by **June 4, 2013**. Fire departments with an “X” have submitted more than six months of data, fire departments with an asterisk (*) have submitted less than six months of data, and fire departments with a yellow field have not submitted any data for those years indicated.

The “Fire Department Data” charts show a breakdown by incident type category of each fire department’s data. Fire department data is only included if the fire department submitted **12 complete months** of data by **June 4, 2013**.

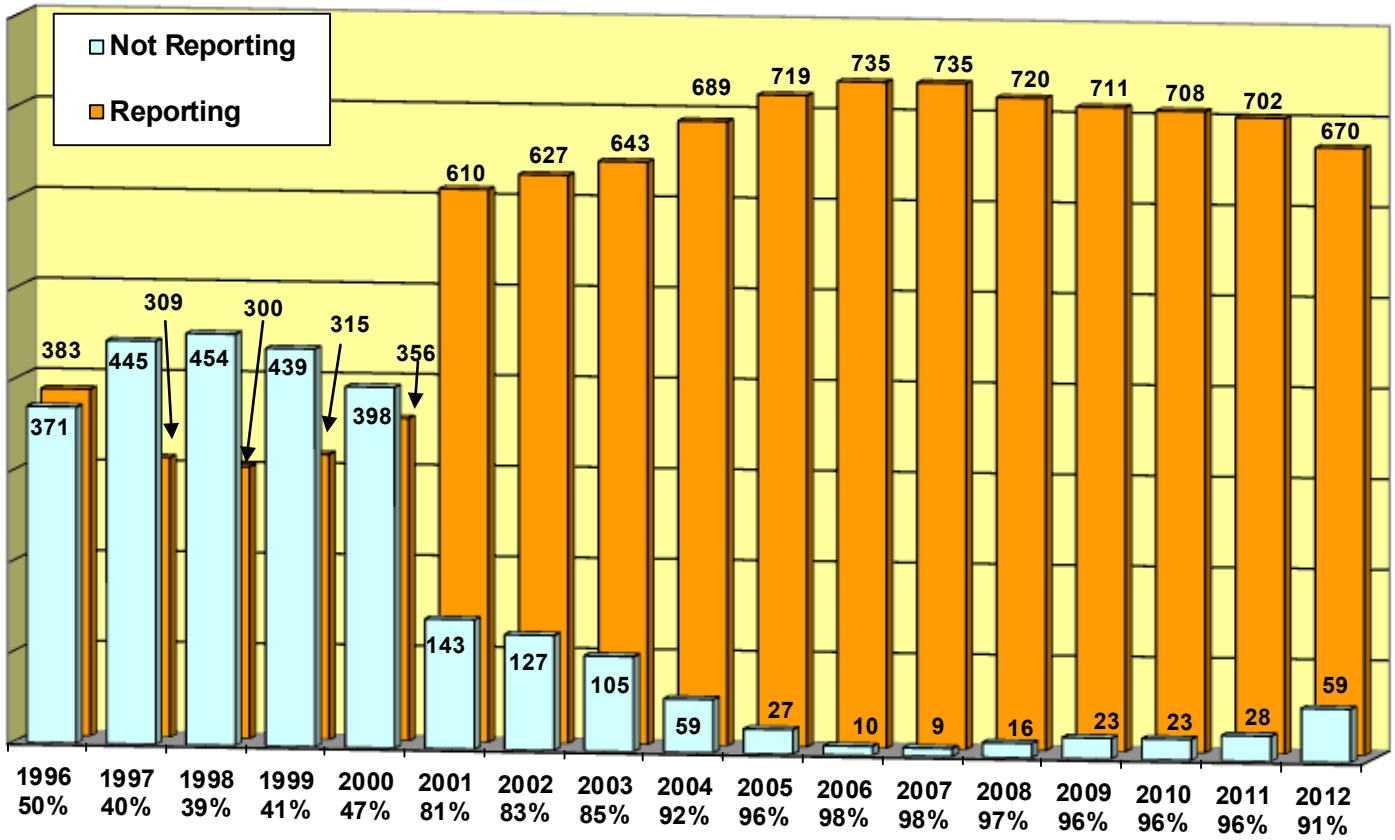

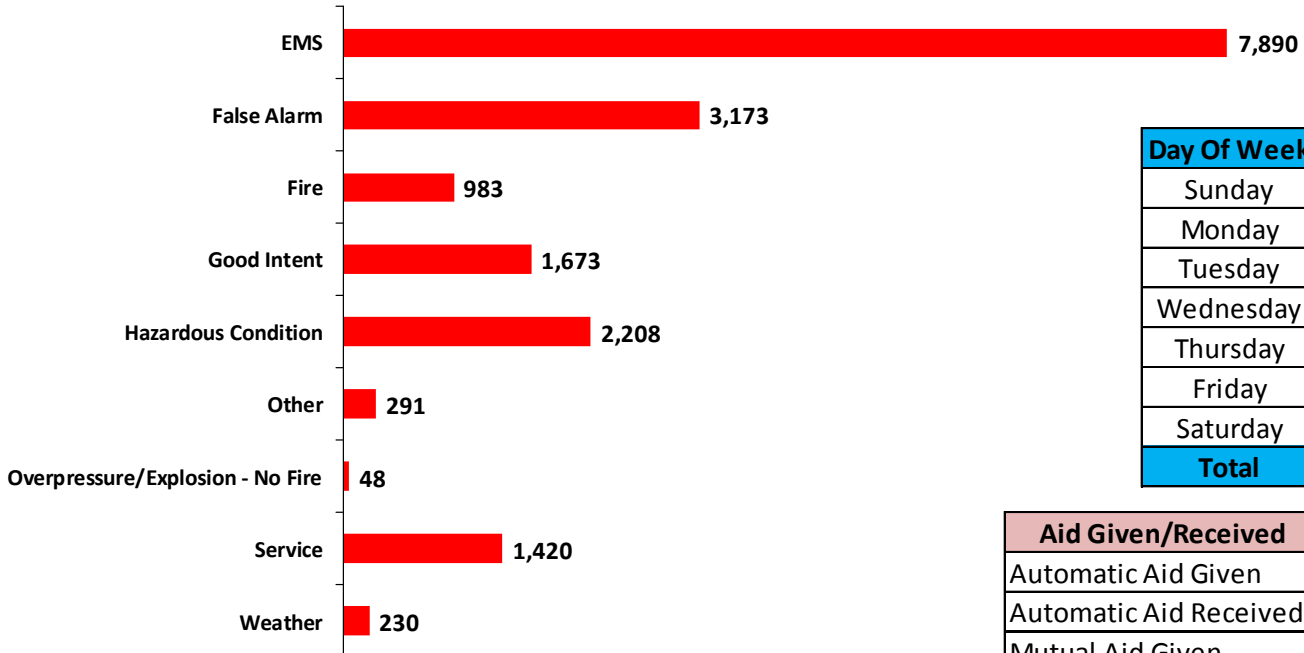

Incident Type Responses By Category



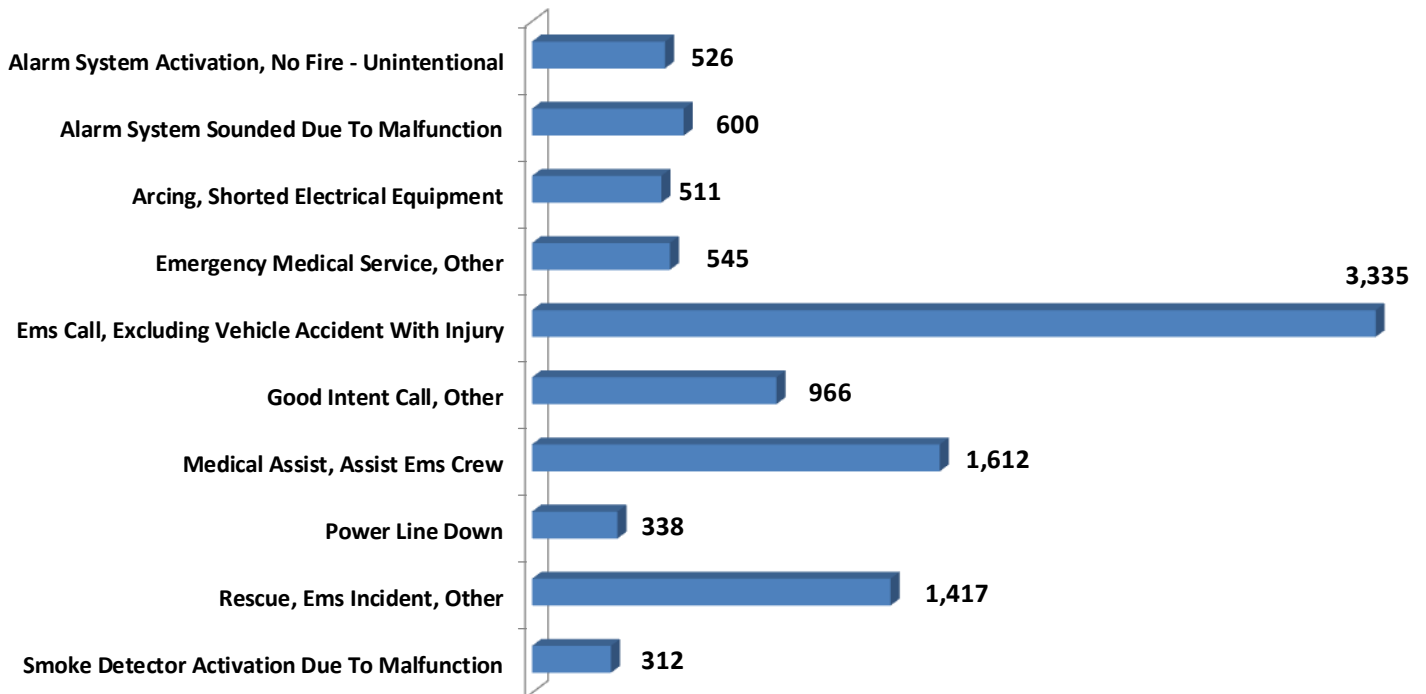

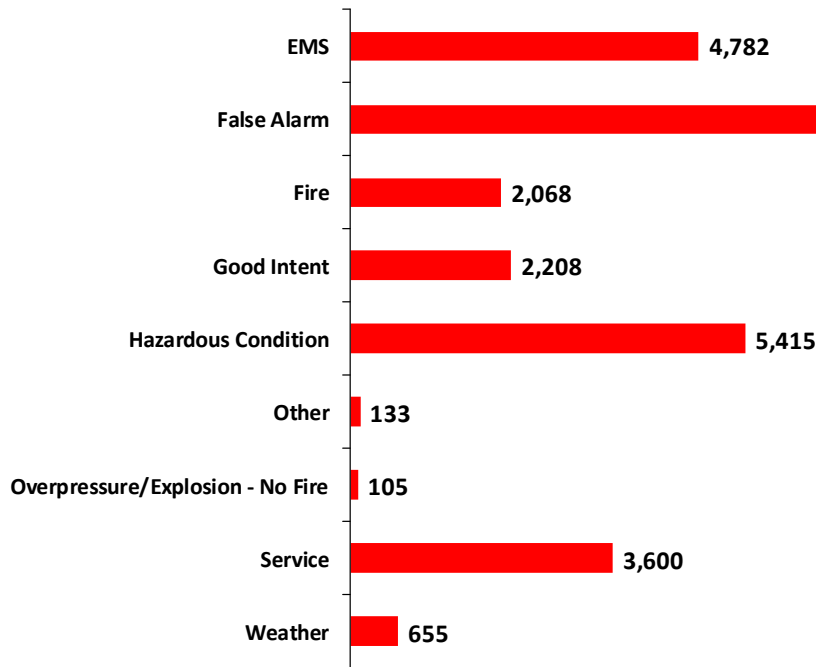

Incident Type Responses By Category



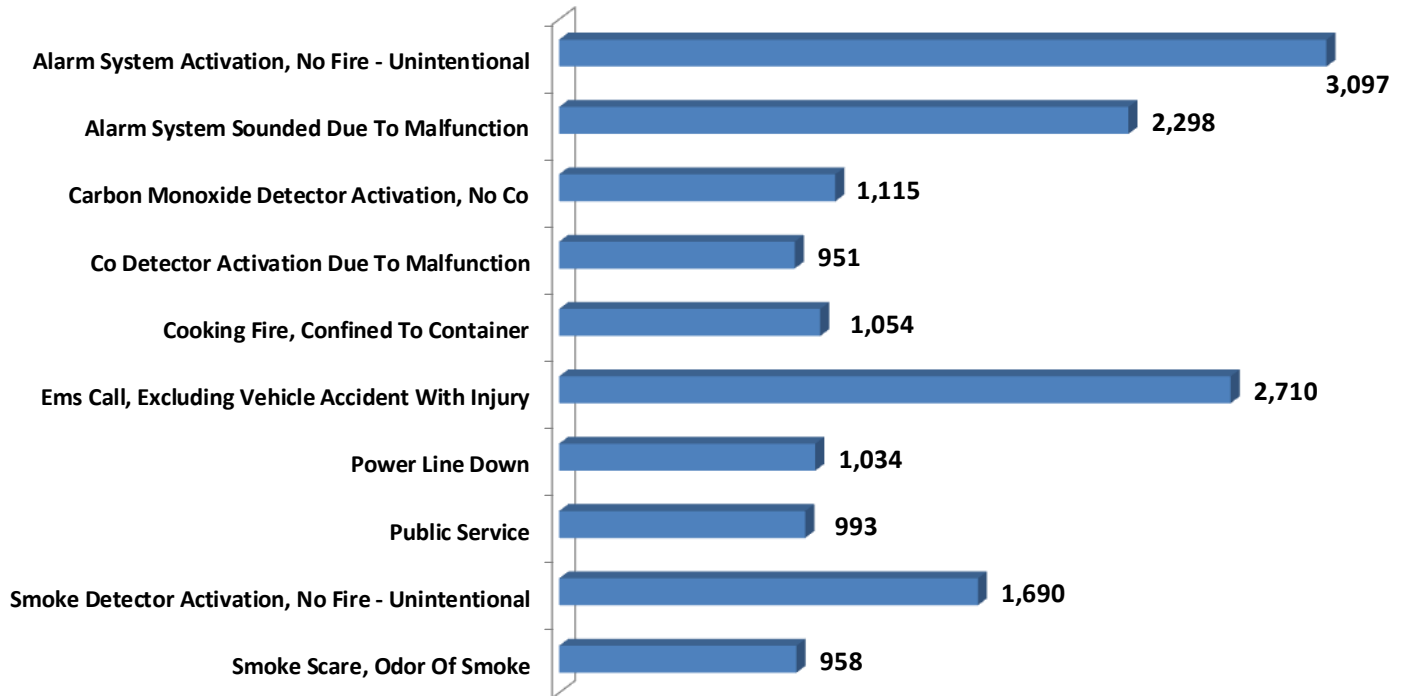

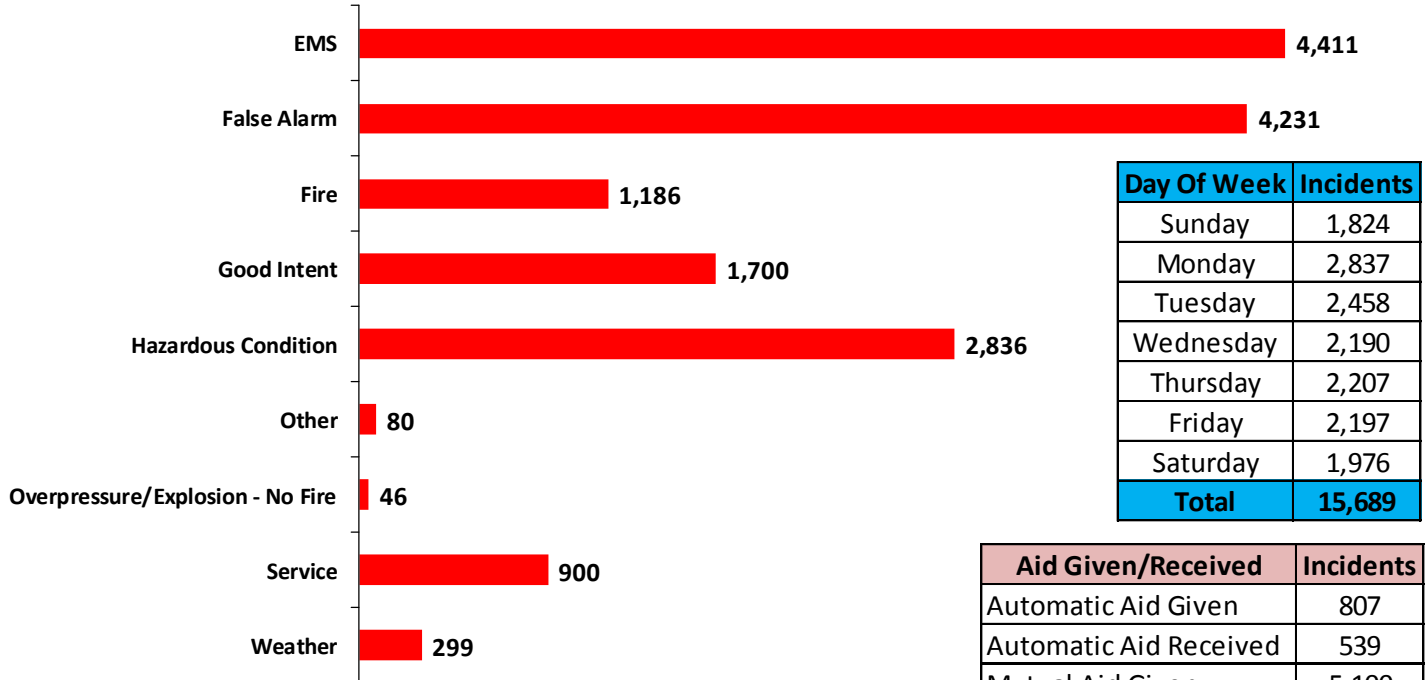

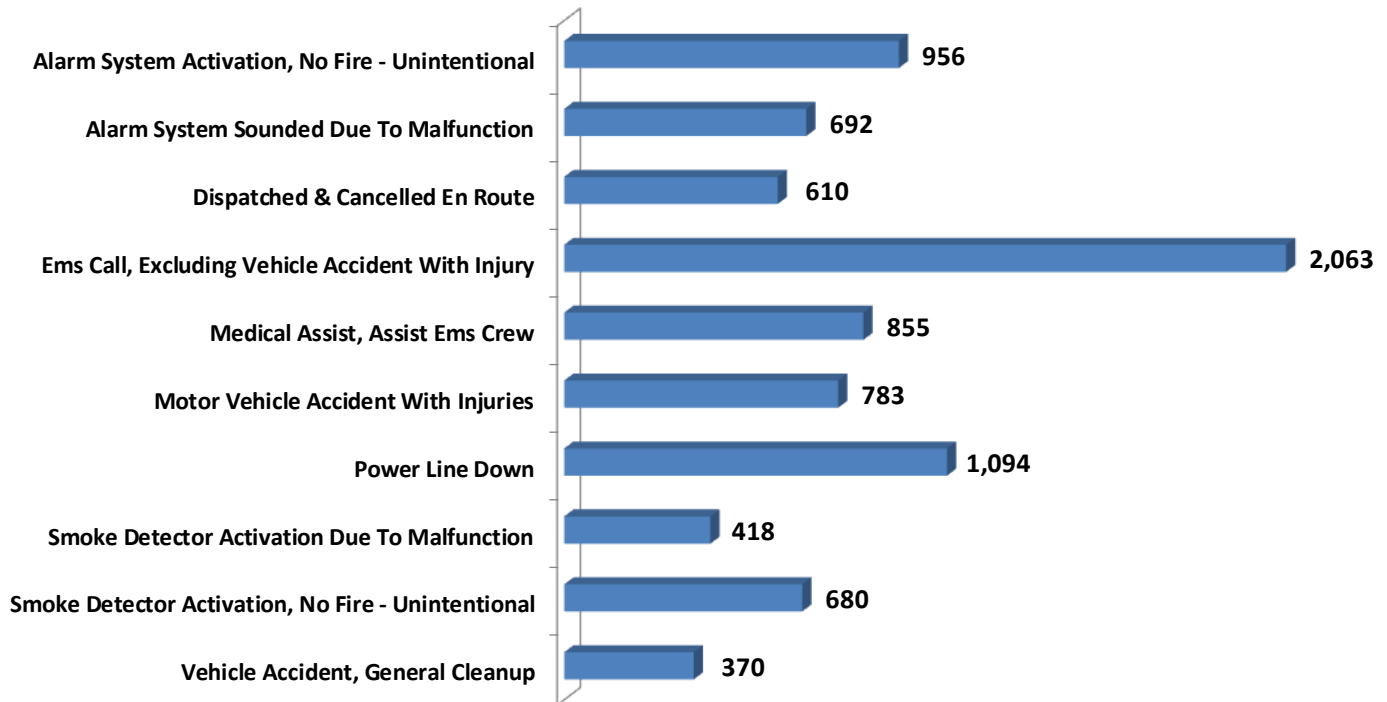

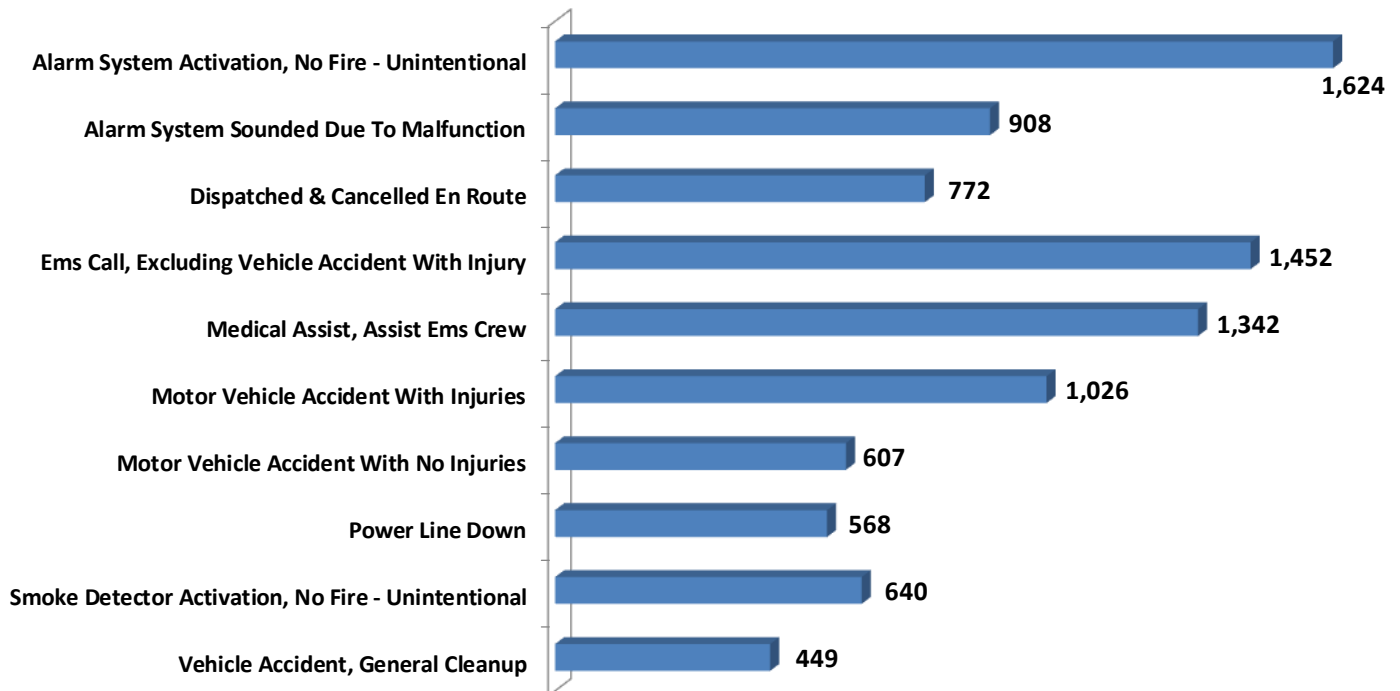

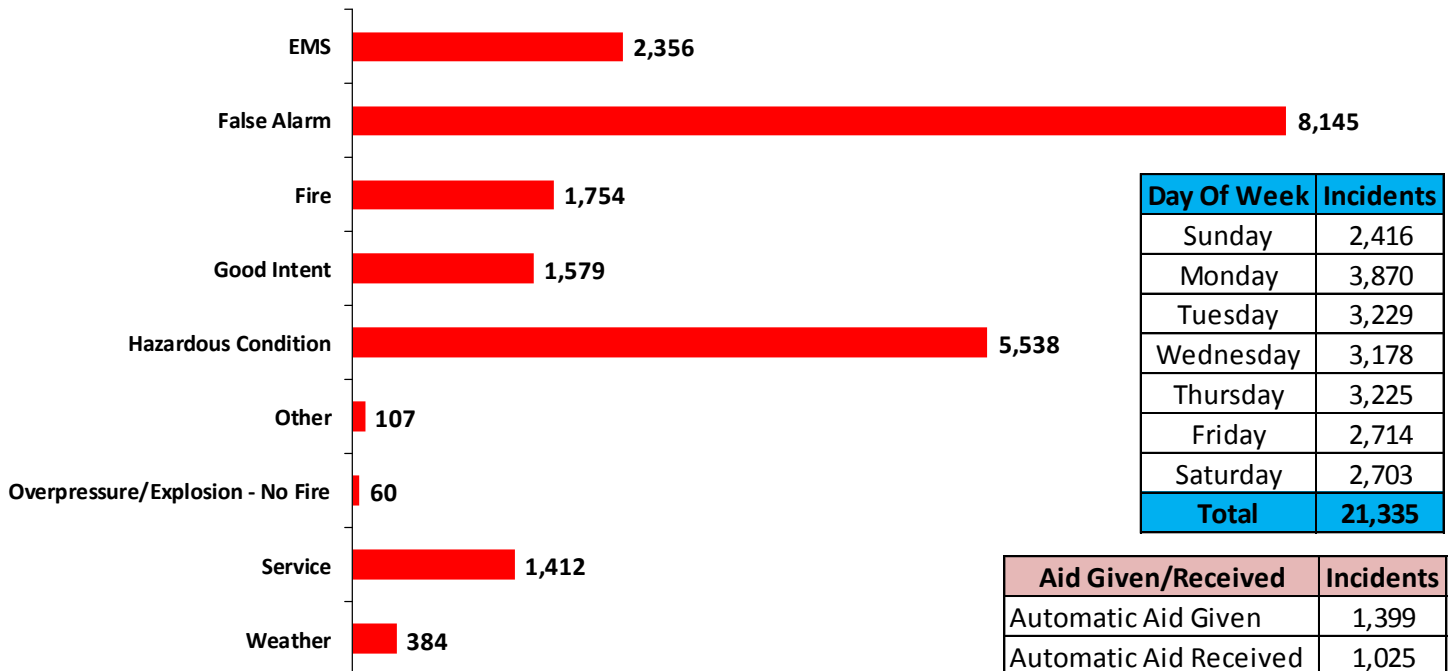

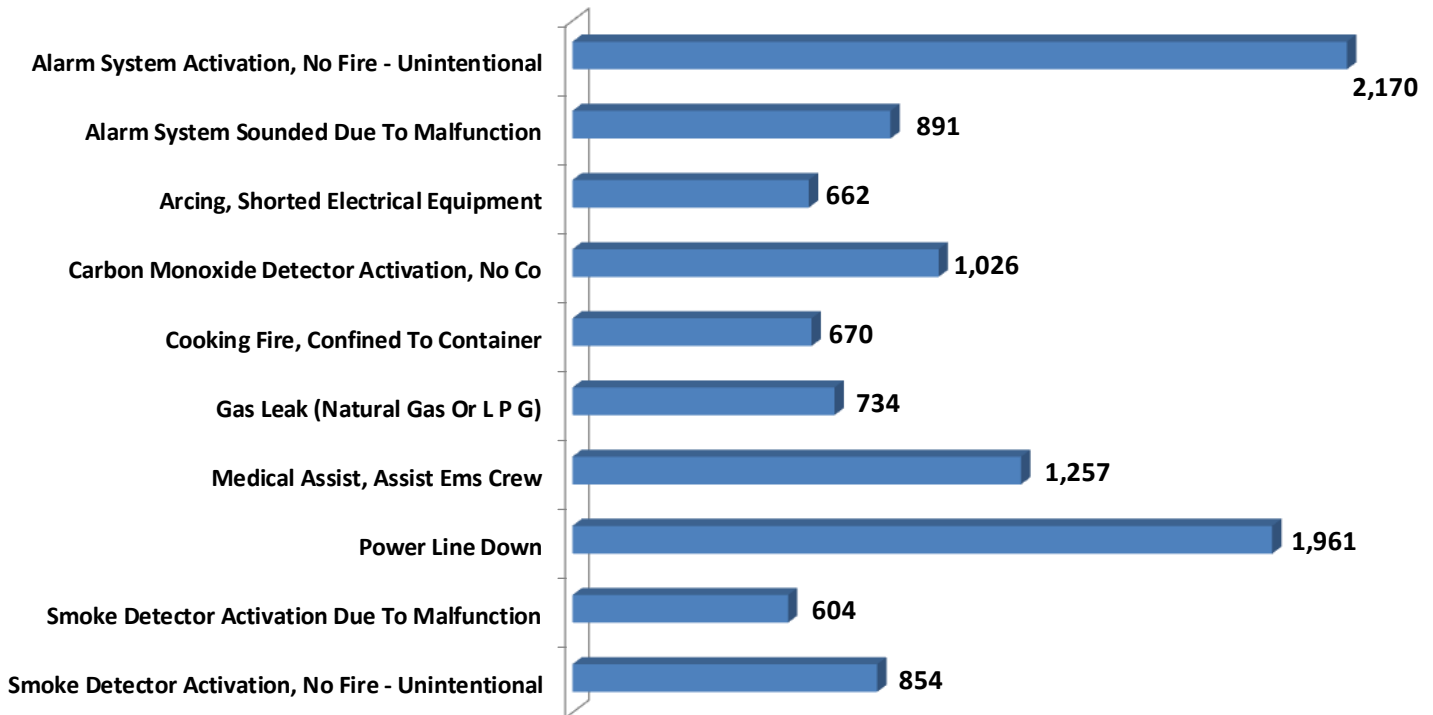

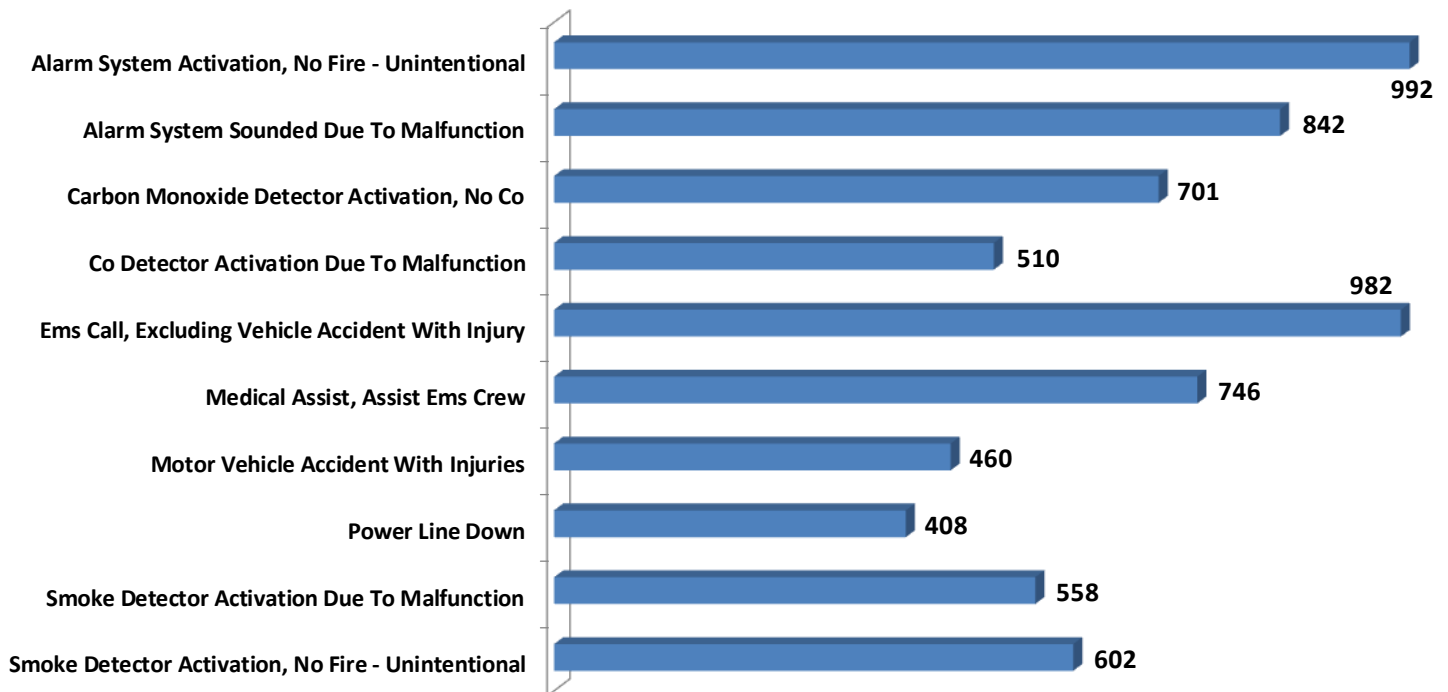

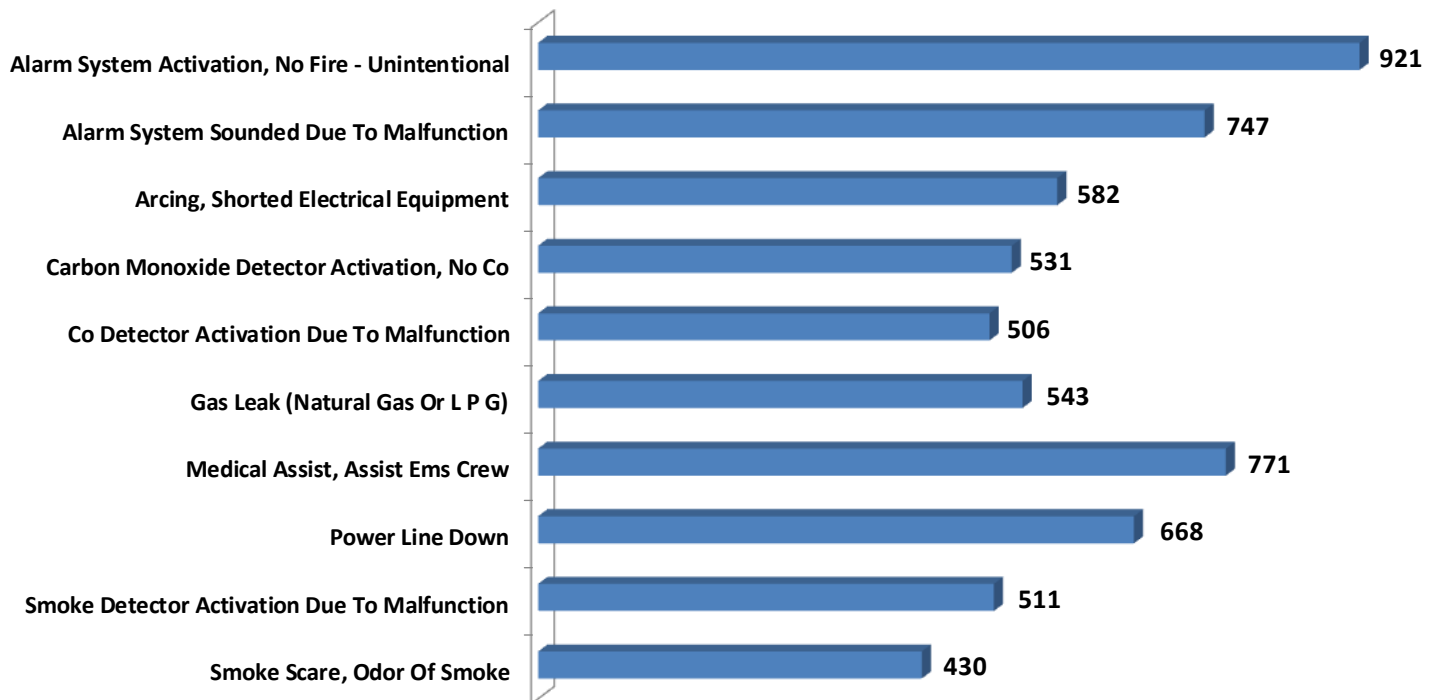
