SPECIAL ADMISSIONS VOUCHERS FOR SUPERSTORM SANDY VICTIMS

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: WHAT ARE SPECIAL ADMISSIONS VOUCHERS?

A: The Superstorm Sandy – Special Admissions Vouchers are HUD funded, Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers, which can be used to assist storm victims by providing an income-based rent subsidy for permanent housing.

Q: WHAT TYPE OF ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE?

A: Eligible applicants will receive a rental assistance voucher, which will assist their household by providing an ongoing rental subsidy.

Q: WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE?

A: Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1. You must have rented an apartment or owned a home that is no longer habitable (can't be lived in) due to damage sustained by Superstorm Sandy.
- 2. You must have registered with FEMA and been found eligible for FEMA housing assistance.
- 3. Your gross household income cannot exceed 40% of median income (waivers up to 50% of median income may be considered).
- 4. The head of household must be a U.S. citizen or legally in the United States.

Q: HOW DO I APPLY FOR THE SUPERSTORM SANDY – SPECIAL ADMISSIONS PROGRAM?

Q: WHAT IF I AM ON AN EXISTING WAITING LIST?

A: Receiving a Special Admission Voucher will not affect your waiting list status.
