

Request For Qualifications For Lead-Based Paint Risk Assessment Services

PROCEED, Inc. is seeking qualified contractors to provide lead-based paint risk assessment and clearance testing services for PROCEED Lead Safe Home Remediation Pilot (LSHR). PROCEED, Inc. is seeking qualifications from NJ qualified Lead Evaluation contractor to be our contracted inspector/assessor for residential properties within Union County, NJ, with a primary focus on the cities of Plainfield and Elizabeth, NJ. PROCEED, will select qualified inspector/assessors who will be utilized to complete all LSHR Based Paint Risk Assessments/Clearances for PROCEED, Inc. from January 1, 2017 through October 31, 2018.

PROCEED LSHR Pilot program is expected to include Home Repair/Rehab and/or similar housing activities which require lead risk assessments/lead evaluation and clearance. Up to 98 units will need risk assessments and clearance testing at this time.

PROCEED, Inc.'s goal is to have small pool of qualified Lead Risk Assessors available to contact when needed to determine the presence of lead-based paint hazards and to establish appropriate Abatement or Interim Controls. The construction work items will be between \$5,000 and \$12,000 per unit, and will require lead-safe Renovation, Remodeling and Rehabilitation and/or Abatement.
