NOTICE is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received on **Friday May 8th, 2015 at 10:30 AM** by the County of Passaic, on the Second Floor of the Passaic County Procurement Center, located at 495 River Street, Paterson, New Jersey, 07524 for the following:

Proposals, Plans, and Specifications may be obtained by pickup at the Passaic County Procurement Center, Second Floor, 495 River Street, Paterson, New Jersey, 07524, during regular business hours (8:30 A.M. - 4:30 P.M.). **Proposals must be submitted on the forms supplied along with 2 additional copies.**

Bidding Documents, Plans and Specifications WILL NOT be mailed. However, overnight delivery by FedEx can be accommodated at bidder's cost.

Prospective Bidders shall telephone at least twenty-four (24) hours, or at least one (1) business day in advance to reserve Bidding Documents, Plans, and Specifications.

Proposals must be received either in person at the hour designated in this advertisement, or previous thereto by Delivery, Mail, Federal Express or United Parcel Service to the County of Passaic, in the Procurement Center, located at 495 River Street, 2nd Floor, Paterson, New Jersey 07524. The County of Passaic is not responsible for any bid proposals that is either mailed or overnight delivered for not arriving at the prevailing bid time and location.

Please take note that some overnight delivery services offer a service which guarantees delivery of your packages by

7:00 A.M. The County Offices are not open at this early hour and some vendors are discovering that the delivery services will not re-attempt delivery of the package until after the bid opening. Please be guided accordingly. It is incumbent upon you, the bidder, to insure that your bid is received and delivered and is not simply attempted to be delivered prior to the bid opening.

The proposal must be accompanied by all documents required by the conditions and specifications for submitting a proposal. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, C. 127, (N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2), concerning Affirmative Action Goals.

The bid must be accompanied by a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders in a corporation or partnership who own ten percent (10%) or greater interest therein.

The bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond, made payable to the County of Passaic Treasurer, for ten percent (10%) of the bid, but not in excess of \$20,000.00, guaranteeing acceptance of the contract, if awarded.

Single prime bids will be received for all work.

The Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Passaic reserves the right to consider the BID PROPOSALS for sixty (60) days after the receipt thereof; and further reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, waive informalities, and make such awards or take action as may be in the best interest of the County.

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
