

Governing Body Action for Bid Exception

Content of a Governing Body Action Approving Purchase That Exceeds Bid Threshold and is Exempt from Public Bidding

An action of a governing body to approve a purchase that exceeds the local unit's bid threshold should include the following elements:

- 1. Identification of the statute (by citation and/or description) that exempts the particular good or service from public bidding.
- 2. Description of the goods or services being purchased and the purpose for which it is to be used.
- 3. The amount of the contract and the source of all funds used for the purchase.
- 4. Any additional explanatory information necessary for public understanding of the matter.
- 5. Vote including the roll call and names of members moving and seconding the action.
- 6. Acknowledgement of the certification of availability of funds.

The action should be recorded in the minutes of the governing body as appropriate.
