Six 3-bedroom, single-family homes to be constructed on vacant lots. Sites to be served by public drinking water and septic systems on each lot. Natural gas is available in the area.

Planning Board Resolution (April 2008) for subdivision and road improvement; Nolan Ave (gravel), Baldwin Ave (paved, w/ sidewalks). R-150 Zone (affordable housing)

The project is located within the coastal zone as defined by the State's Coastal Zone Management Program. Per NJDEP response dated 2/7/14, a CAFRA permit is not required as the development is greater than 500' from the MHWL and consists of less than 25 dwelling units. Per NJDEP response dated 2/7/14, a Coastal Wetlands permit is not required based on absence of Coastal Wetlands.

The proposed project is not located on or near wetlands – no permit required.
