We are performing an CEST review for the referenced project site as part of the funding process under the New Jersey Economic Development Authority's Neighborhood and Community Revitalization (NCR) program - this application is identified as NCR39441. Due to the unique nature of this project, there is no centroid data for the site that returns a simple "Yes" or "No" answer for the presence of federally and state-listed T&E species.

This project does not require a land use permit.
