The purpose of this project is to implement streetscape improvements along Main Street from 10th Avenue to 5th Avenue in the Borough of Belmar. The improvements would complement previous streetscape work completed along Main Street from 16th Avenue to 10th Avenue and provide a cohesive appearance for the borough's downtown commercial area.			
The proposed project improvements include installation of existing pavers; repair and replacement of sidewalk and curb; inclusion of 28 street/pedestrian lights; planting/replanting of 50 shade trees; installation of detectable warning surfaces, and new paver sidewalk.			
Excavation will be limited to tree planting, installation of wiring for lighting, curb, crosswalk and sidewalk replacement. No net change in impervious coverage would occur and no building or façade improvements would be undertaken.
