The proposed project will consist two phases. Phase I will consist of the reconstruction and elevation of the existing bulkheads at 117 and 205 Channel Drive. A concrete esplanade will be installed behind the bulkhead and sidewalk and landscaping improvements along Baltimore Avenue will be conducted to allow for increased public access to the waterfront. Existing fishing equipment will be relocated from 205 Channel Drive to 301 Channel Drive. The buildings at 205 and 209 channel drive will be demolished. The building at 301 Channel Drive will be rehabilitated and modernized with an approximately 3,000 square-foot second story addition. The property's 18,000-gallon double-walled diesel tank will be relocated from its current location, in the center of the property, to a location adjacent to the building at 301 Channel Drive.

Phase II of the project will consist of the demolition of the building at 117 Channel Drive and the construction of a hotel building on this parcel. In addition, a restaurant building will be constructed at 205 Channel Drive. Due to FEMA floodplain requirements, the hotel and restaurant are proposed to be elevated above the base flood elevation, with the parking incorporated beneath and surrounding the structures. It is noted that the funding being sought in this application will be used only on Phase I. Funding for Phase II will be obtained separately.
