The ENSP has concluded that project "NCR39562" will not affect Northern Long-Eared Bat based on the following: Though the project may require limited clearing of trees, the extent of mature woody vegetation on site is quite limited and does not appear suitable for Northern Long-Eared Bats. Therefore no bat species are expected to be present. This project may commence without concern regarding "take" of Northern Long-Eared Bats.
