Rikkia, just talked to David Moskovits and his environmental attorney, Diana L. Bongiorno of Wolff & Samson, concerning this non-compliance matter. The persons that she is dealing with at DEP are Alphonso and Sarah (last names not provided). According to Alphonso who apparently was not aware of the Stronger NJ Business Loan environmental assessment, the non-compliance issue involves two issues:

- (1) Clean up of a site adjacent to Superior-MPM LLC site owned by Duraport Marine and Rail Terminal. Apparently, the Duraport and Superior sites were owned by Rollins Corp. and leased to Dow Chemical and Bayer Chemical under Lot #10. Superior purchased only that portion of Lot 10 on which the 115,000 square foot building that houses DC Plastic Products Corp and the remainder of Lot 10 was purchased by Duraport. The portion purchased by Superior kept the designation of Lot 10 while the Duraport portion was renamed Lot 4.02. However, DEP still has both lots as Lot 10 which as stated is owned by Superior. According to Ms. Bongiorno, DEP is in the process of correcting this discrepancy.
- (2) Non-payment of the LSRP fees owed to DEP in the amount of \$8,055. David Moskovits will immediately sent this amount to DEP to clear this issue.

Hopefully, the clearance of the above two issues will remove the non-compliance status so that DEP approval of the Sandy environmental assessment can be secured.
