After questioning the homeowner about the purpose of the pipe, the owner indicated that the pipe was related to an out of service water supply well. We also discussed the issue and sent photos to Bill Lindner of NJDEP as per the protocol for identifying potential RECs. ## Diane-

I have attached the UST guidance document that we prepared for our contractors. In my opinion, the visible pipe at the 1745 North Avenue address in Commercial Township (Cumberland) is not a fill pipe for two reasons; first, there is no accompanying vent pipe which would be necessary and second, the pipe in the photograph has threads on the inside (it appears that there is a cap screwed on), a fill pipe has threads outside to accommodate the fill nozzle that is screwed on with a collar while filling.
