According to the damage assessment (see above) the estimated work-inprogress repairs is \$29,218.50. The form states that the FEMA estimated home value is \$121,000. The cost to repair is less than 50% of the value of the home; therefore, the project is not classified as a substantial rehabilitation (i.e., elevation is not required).
