

Access to the Specialized Residential Treatment Unit (SRTU)

- A youth has been on the Bulletin Board for 30 days and there are no clear prospects for acceptance into any out-of-home treatment programs;
- A youth has been assigned a SPEC (specialty) level of treatment;
- A youth has been assigned a PCR (Psychiatric Community Residence) level of treatment;
