

**ACCESS TO THE SPECIALIZED RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT UNIT (SRTU)
CHILDREN'S SYSTEM OF CARE
(Updated 9/26/12)**

SRTU Consultation is provided for:

- A youth who has been assigned a SPEC (Specialty) Intensity of Service, PCH (Psychiatric Community Home) Intensity of Service, or a youth in need of a treatment program for pregnant teens;
- SRTU is not an emergency placement resource;
- The preferred method of communicating with the SRTU is e-mail, which should include the youth's CYBER# and the reason for the assistance request;

***PLEASE NOTE: EFFECTIVE 10/1/12, SRTU WILL NO LONGER PROVIDE CONSULTATIVE SERVICES FOR TH, GH, AND RTC REFERRALS THAT ARE ON YOUTH LINK 30+ DAYS; CONSULTATION FOR THESE INTENSITIES OF SERVICE ARE NOW PROVIDED THROUGH PERFORMCARE; MORE INFORMATION REGARDING TIER II CONSULTATION IS AVAILABLE ON THE PERFORMCARE WEBSITE AT <http://www.performcarenj.org/provider/forms.aspx>.**
