The following are the *minimum* staffing credentials and requirements for a DCF contracted provider of Residential Treatment Services (RTC) Intensity of Service (IOS) for Youth with Co-Occurring Mental Health and Intellectual / Developmental Diagnoses for one cluster of three (3) five-bed houses. This is not to be interpreted as comprehensive of the total responsibilities each staff member will manage.

Staff requirements are divided by Staff dedicated to each house and Hub Professional Staff.

## Required program staff to youth ratio:

Each house must maintain a ratio of 1 milieu support staff for every 5 youth at all hours. A minimum of two staff members (milieu or professional\*) must be awake, on site, and accessible to youth at all times whenever any youth are present, including overnight while youth are asleep.

<u>\*</u> Professionals who serve as the second staff person awake in the house may include Program Directors, House Managers, Program Coordinators, Clinicians, Therapists, [Behavioral Assistants,]; and Health Care providers; all staff must be aware of youths' respective crisis management plans.
