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#### **Clarification**

**On page 2 under Funding Information, it states that work must be started and funds obligated by March 1, 2016. This is corrected to say March 1, 2017.**

- 1. Can separate applications be submitted by an organization with more than one location? Can an agency submit multiple proposals if its programs do not currently have generators?**

Yes, with a limit of no more than 3.

- 2. Can an agency submit a proposal for the purchase of multiple generators for separate buildings? Our agency has numerous locations, and I'd like to get an idea as to the score of the award. I know that a maximum award shall be \$30,000, but is that \$30,000 for each location, each proposal, each agency, etc.? Could an agency with multiple locations request additional funding or submit additional proposals? If \$30,000 is the max award, could it be used to purchase generators for multiple locations?**

Yes, \$30,000 for each location. No more than three proposals.

**3. Re: eligibility requirements for this funding opportunity.**

**We operate a transitional living program that receives funding from DCF. However, it is housed in a facility that serves other (non-DCF-funded) programs as well. It is the only residential program at the facility. Are we eligible to apply?**

Yes.

**4. Our agency was recently awarded a service contract through DCF for a new group home for girls which had a provision attributable to the installation of a whole home generator as required by the grant. However, the property now requires a larger and costlier generator than first anticipated. Can our agency apply through this grant to support the balance of funding needed to properly equip this facility?**

Yes, your application should fully explain and support this request.

**5. Does the funding for generators apply only to buildings that children live in? Or is it applicable to other essential facilities such as a cafeteria, etc.?**

Yes, only the residential facilities providing 24 hour care are eligible for this funding.

**6. Are we able to reapply for funding for a generator that we previously applied for in September 2016?**

Yes, you may re-apply for the same project.
