1. Can an agency be LLC or are we required to be a Corporation?

Per the Applicant Eligibility Requirements on page 13, "Applicants must be universities (State or private) or not-for-profit corporations that are duly registered to conduct business within the State of New Jersey.

2. RFP – Bottom of pg. 6 – "Housing Intervention"

a. Please confirm that DCF has already identified the five projected housing units.

Yes, DCF has already identified the five projected housing units to be used for this program.

b. Are these five units in the same building?

The five units are located within the same apartment site/complex.

c. Which Hudson municipality is the building located in, and what is the street address (or at least the neighborhood)?

The five projected housing units are located in the A. Harry Moore complex at 330 Duncan Avenue in Jersey City.

d. Is there a space in the building such as a "Community Room" which could be used for group-based activities?
