In the document HR010 - Restaurant Controls, there is a table identifying the costs for controls on restaurants derived from a staff report at VCAPCD in California. As the manufacturer of this equipment, we would like to provide the actual costs for this equipment. We were surprised by the high cost estimates in that document. More importantly, it did not reflect the cost savings achieved by installing the catalyst onto the charbroiler.
