

**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT
ON DRAFT AIR POLLUTION CONTROL RENEWAL OPERATING PERMIT (TITLE V)**

The New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) is seeking public comment on its intent to approve an air pollution control Operating Permit Renewal for Lamart Corporation, pursuant to the provisions of Title V of the Federal Clean Air Act, the federal rules promulgated at 40 CFR 70, and the state regulations promulgated at N.J.A.C. 7:27-22. These rules require existing facilities with a potential to emit major amounts of air contaminants to obtain an operating permit which specifies the air pollution control requirements that apply to the facility; the maximum amount of air pollutants which can be emitted; and the monitoring, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements to assure compliance.

Lamart Corporation is located at 16 Richmond Street, Clifton, NJ and consists of a pressure sensitive tape manufacturer. Lamart Corporation is owned and operated by Lamart Corporation Owner.

The facility is classified as a major facility based on its potential to emit 45.4 tons per year of volatile organic compounds) to the atmosphere. It is also classified as a major hazardous air pollutant (HAP) facility. A major HAP emitting facility is designated as major when the allowed emissions exceed 10 tons per year of any individual hazardous air pollutant or 25 tons per year of any combination of individual hazardous air pollutants that may be emitted simultaneously.

The draft permit allows any individual hazardous air pollutant to be emitted at a rate to not exceed: 70,800 pounds per year of glycol ethers, 74,500 pounds per year of hexane (n-), 70,800 pounds per year of methanol, 79,120 pounds per year of toluene, 70,800 pounds per year of xylene and 920 pounds per year of vinyl acetate.

The equipment that emits air contaminants from this facility include: six surface coaters, four surface coating dryers combustion natural gas with two thermal oxidizers with no less 95% reduction efficiency for volatile organic compound emissions, natural gas fired air makeup unit, four corona treaters, two ultrasonic curing lamps, holding and mixing tanks and lab coater.

The conditions of approval for this renewal operating permit are based on conditions of approval in all applicable preconstruction permits for equipment at this facility, and on applicable requirements in state and federal air pollution control rules. Consistent with 40 CFR 70.7(a)(5), each condition in the permit includes the citation of the applicable requirement on which the condition is based.

This permit action proposes to allow the [Lamart Corporation](#) to continue operation of existing equipment that emits air contaminants to the atmosphere. Before a final renewal permit is issued, the public has this opportunity to comment on the draft permit.

The Responsible Official at the facility has certified that the facility currently meets all applicable requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act and the New Jersey Air Pollution Control Act. Based on this certification, and the Department's evaluation of the information included in the facility's application, the Department has concluded that this air pollution control operating permit should be approved to allow operation of the existing facility for five years. Prior to the expiration of the five year period, the facility will be required to apply for a renewal of this operating permit, at which time the Department will evaluate the facility and issue a public notice with its findings.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:27-22.11(f), any person may request that the Department hold a public hearing on the draft permit. A request for a public hearing shall be submitted, in writing, within thirty days of the date of this notice to the Department at the Trenton address listed above. The request for public hearing shall include a statement of issues to be discussed at the public hearing. The statement of issues shall be relevant to the draft permit under review by the Department.
