


## ***New Jersey ASE Certification Status Verification Process***

- 1) Providing ASE certification status is a simple process using your personal account page (Setup following ASE test). Have the following information available, as you may need it if you don't yet have an ASE Account:
  - a) Full Legal Name
  - b) Contact Information
  - c) Date of Birth
  - d) Last four digits of your Social Security Number
- 2) Prior to following the steps below, you will have to have created your ASE Account. This can be done on the ASE website.
- 3) Click on the following link to access and login to the ASE website.

- 5) After you have logged into your account, under the "Certification" tab, click on the "View Status Letter" button located at the bottom of the page.
