New Jersey Emission Repair Technician (ERT) Initial Certification Requirements Effective 2015

Track I - the Test Option

- Certification in the Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) A6, A8, and L1 tests is required.
- Certification in the ASE A9 Light Vehicle Diesel Engines test, **or** successful completion of the Emission Technician Education Program (ETEP) Section 7 and the 2015 ETEP Section 9 "Advanced Light Duty Diesel Technologies", is required.
- Certification in the new ASE L3 Light Duty Hybrid Electric Vehicles test, **or** successful completion of the 2015 ETEP Section 10 "Hybrid/Electric Technologies", is required.
- Attendance at the 2009 New Jersey Specific Informational Course, **or** a 2009 New Jersey Inspector Training Course, is required.

Track II - the Education Option

- Successful completion of ETEP Sections 1 through 6 is required.
- Successful completion of the 2015 ETEP Section 8 "Advanced Gasoline Technologies" is required.
- Successful completion of ETEP Section 7 and the 2015 ETEP Section 9 "Advanced Light Duty Diesel Technologies", **or** certification in the ASE A9 Light Vehicle Diesel Engines test, is required.
- Successful completion of the 2015 ETEP Section 10 "Hybrid/Electric Technologies", **or** certification in the new ASE L3 Light Duty Hybrid Electric Vehicles test, is required.
- Attendance at the 2009 New Jersey Specific Informational Course, **or** a 2009 New Jersey Inspector Training Course, is required.

One of the above tracks must be completed in its entirety before applying for certification.
