Permit Descriptions

CAFRA - A Coastal Area Facility Act permit is required to construct residential, commercial, public, transportation, utility and energy-related facilities in the coastal area as defined by the Act.

Federal Consistency Activity: Certain federal permits, not limited to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permits, require certification by the DEP prior to the issuance of the permit by the federal agency.

Flood Hazard Area: A Flood Hazard permit or verification is required for disturbances within the floodway or floodplain in areas regulated under the Flood Hazard Area Control Act.

Freshwater Wetlands: A Permit (Letters of Exemption, Letters of Interpretation, Statewide General Permit, Open Water Fill, Individual, Transition Area Waiver, Water Quality Certificate) is needed prior to engaging in a regulated activity in or around freshwater wetlands and associated transition areas. A Flood Hazard Area Permit, an U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permit, and a Water Quality Certification may also be required.

General Groundwater Petroleum Products Cleanup: This general permit authorizes the surface water discharge of treated groundwater previously contaminated with petroleum products.

NJPDES permits: A permit is required for the discharge of pollutants to surface and groundwater, a discharge from an indirect user or the land application of municipal and/or industrial residuals. (A more comprehensive definition of activities, which require a permit, may be found at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-2.4)

Solid Waste Facility: A permit is required to conduct or operate any solid waste facility as defined under the Solid Waste Management Act, N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 7:26-1 et seq.

Special Highlands Resource: A Highland Preservation Area Approval is required for regulated activities within the Highland Preservation Area as defined in the Highlands Water Protection & Planning Act Preservation Area Rules.

Tidal Wetlands: A Coastal Wetlands Permit is needed to excavate, dredge, fill or erect structures on coastal wetlands.

Treatment Works Approval: A TWA permit is required for the construction, modification or operation of a treatment works, including sanitary/industrial sewage pretreatment or treatment systems, sewage conveyance systems, sewer extensions and subsurface sewage disposal systems.

Waterfront Development: A permit is required for any project involving the development of waterfront near or upon any tidal or navigable waterway in the State.

Coastal Wetlands: A permit authorizing disturbances to Mapped Tidal Wetlands under the Wetlands Act of 1970, N.J.S.A. 13:9A”

General Information

The DEP Bulletin is an information service provided by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. In compliance with the Rules and Regulations Governing 90 Day Construction Permits (NJAC 7:1C-1.1 et seq.) this semi-monthly publication contains a list of construction permit applications recently filed or acted upon by the DEP. Using the Application Milestone Codes located on the inside front cover, interested persons can determine the status of Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permits, Federal Consistency Activity permits, Freshwater Wetlands Individual and Statewide General permits, General Groundwater Petroleum Products Cleanup permits, Open Water Fill permits, Solid Waste Facility permits (SWF), Flood Hazard Area (FHA) permits, Tidal Wetlands permits, Waterfront Development permits and Treatment Works Approvals (TWA).

In addition, a calendar of Events of Interest and a Schedule of Public Hearings is provided. The public hearings listed do not, however, constitute an official notice. Environmental Impact Statements acted upon during the period are also shown. Additional information concerning the permit applications can be obtained by calling the project manager at the appropriate office listed on the inside back cover.

Public Hearings are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide or of broad general interest and open to the public.

Contested Case Hearings are held between the State and a particular party involving an application, enforcement violation or an appeal. Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

DEP Events of Public Interest include public hearings, council meetings, workshops, public information meetings, and exams.

ADOPTED AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN
PUBLIC NOTICE**

Take notice that on January 16, 2014, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County WQMP was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This amendment, entitled “Bankbridge Development”, submitted on behalf of Planland, LLC, expands the sewer service area (SSA) of the Gloucester County Utilities Authority (GCUA) Wastewater Treatment Plant (WTP) to include 135 four-bedroom single family homes on Block 398, Lots 31-33 & 52; and Block 399, Lots 2, 4, 5, 6, 8, & 17-41 in Deptford Township, Gloucester County. The subject property, located on the western side of Route 663/Tanyard Road, and bisected by Woodcreek-Bankbridge Road, totals approximately 170 acres. Portions of the property are already shown to be within GCUA’s existing SSA. Therefore, the GCUA SSA is expanded by approximately 79 acres in order to accommodate the entire development.

This amendments updates the GCUA Consolidated District Wastewater Management Plan (WMP), adopted December 10, 2008 (see 41 N.J.R. 671(a), January 20, 2009), to include the Bankbridge Development in the GCUA SSA. This application has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules that set the environmental standards to be applied to an amendment at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.18, N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25.

Pursuant to P.L. 2011, c. 203, the Department, in consultation with the applicable wastewater management planning agency, may approve the inclusion of land within a SSA notwithstanding that existing treatment works may not currently have the assured capacity to treat wastewater from such land without infrastructure improvements or permit modification. Therefore, amendments to modify a SSA may be approved if such actions are compliant with the applicable sections of the Water Quality Management Planning rule (N.J.A.C. 7:15) regardless of whether capacity has been fully assessed, however, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)1, the projected wastewater flow of the project has been evaluated. The projected wastewater flow, as calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A is 40,500 gallons per day (gpd). Though the GCUA Consolidated District WMP, adopted December 10, 2008, identifies the GCUA WTP as being permitted at 24.1 million gallons per day (mgd), currently, the GCUA WTP, discharging under permit number NJ0024686, has a permitted capacity of 27 mgd. The GCUA WTP discharges to the Delaware River, a designated Category 2 (C2), Fresh Water 2, Non-Trout, Saline Estuarine 2 (FW2-NT\SE2) waterway, as classified under the Surface Water Quality Standards, N.J.A.C. 7:9B. The average of the last twelve months of discharge monitoring data show that GCUA WTP has discharged an average daily flow of 17.058 MGD. The additional 0.0405 MGD of wastewater will not cause the wastewater generation potential of the expanded SSA to exceed the 27 mgd permitted capacity of GCUA WTP.

The GCUA WTP provides treatment for the northern portion of Gloucester County known as the Consolidated District. Along with Deptford Township, the Consolidated District includes Clayton Borough, Glassboro Borough, Mantua Township, National Park Borough, Paulsboro Borough, Pitman Borough, Washington Township, Wenonah Borough, West Deptford Township, Westville Borough, Woodbury City, Woodbury Heights Borough, and portions of East Greenwich Township, Elk Township and Monroe Township. As part of the Gloucester County Consolidated District WMP, an environmental constraints/build out analysis was performed for each municipality in order to identify future wastewater needs. Based on the analysis, Deptford Township has a projected need to treat a total residential wastewater flow of 3.76 mgd, which has been included in the build out analysis for the GCUA WTP. This proposed amendment to include the Bankbridge development in the GCUA SSA, which would add 0.0405 mgd of wastewater flow to the GCUA WTP can be accommodated within the Township’s apportioned flow of 3.76 mgd without modification to existing facilities.

As outlined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, sewer service may only be provided to areas that are not identified as environmentally sensitive areas (ESAs), Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas, beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, ESAs are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape

Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands, alone or in combination. These areas are not included in the adopted SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, version 3.1. Areas identified by the Landscape Project as being suitable habitat for threatened and endangered species Ranks 3 (State threatened), 4 (State endangered), and 5 (Federal endangered or threatened) are not to be included in adopted SSAs except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h), or unless a site has undergone a site specific Habitat Suitability Determination prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.26 that found the site to be not suitable habitat, or pursuant with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(g)2, the Department determined the ESA is not critical to a population of endangered or threatened species the loss of which would decrease the likelihood of the survival or recovery of the identified species. Review of the project site has determined that no threatened or endangered species habitat exists on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2, areas mapped as Natural Heritage Priority Sites are not to be included in adopted SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). Review of the project site has determined that no Natural Heritage Priority Sites exist on site.

A Riparian zone has been identified on the project site. Riparian zones or buffers are established along all surface waters, based on the surface water body's classification designated at N.J.A.C. 7:9B, under the following regulations: the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules, the Stormwater Management rules, and the Water Quality Management Planning rules. The required buffer width for the Monongahela Brook, its tributaries, and Monongahela Lake, which are all designated FW2-NT waterbodies, is 50 feet, to be measured from the top-of-bank of the regulated streams and from the normal water limit of the lake. Deptford Township does not have a local ordinance that is in full compliance with the aforementioned regulations. To become compliant, and in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)5i, the Riparian Corridor Analysis has been satisfied by applying the 50 foot buffer to the applicable portions of Monongahela Brook, its tributaries, and Monongahela Lake and removing from the adopted SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)4, areas mapped as wetlands pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:9A-1 and 13:9B-25 are not to be included in adopted SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e)2, Letter of Interpretation, L.O.I. # 0802-13-0003.1, was submitted to refute the current Department mapped wetlands delineation, confirming the presence and boundary of an intermediate resource value wetlands, requiring a 50-foot buffer. In compliance with the LOI, the adopted SSA excludes both the mapped wetlands and associated 50-foot buffer.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d), areas with Federal 201 grant limitations that prohibit the extension of sewers to serve development in these areas are excluded from adopted SSAs. There are no prohibitions written into the Federal 201 grants awarded to GCUA WTP for sewer extensions.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)6, development disturbance is not to be located in areas with steep slopes, defined as any slope greater than 20 percent. There are no steep slopes on the subject site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3 the water supply need for the project has been evaluated. Water supply for the development will be provided by the Deptford Township Water & Sewer Department which withdraws and treats water from the Upper Potomac-Raritan-Magothy Aquifer. Water use analysis indicates that the 2.604 mgd allocation currently permitted under WAP090001 is sufficient to meet the Township's needs and will not require modification to serve the development.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)4, a project or activity's stormwater management is to be evaluated. However, P.L. 2011, c. 203 directs there be a presumption that an engineered subdivision or site plan is not required. Without such information a review and determination of compliance with the Stormwater Management rules (N.J.A.C. 7:8) is not possible. The county and local governments are responsible for review and implementation of the Stormwater Management rules during their review and approval of the development. Deptford Township has adopted

stormwater management ordinances (No. 7-2006 and 01-2008) which comply with the performance standards of the Stormwater Management Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:8.

This amendment proposal was noticed in the New Jersey Bulletin on November 6, 2013 at Volume 37, Issue 21 as well as in the South Jersey Times and no comments were received during the comment period.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues may need to be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: compliance with stormwater regulations; antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND OPPORTUNITY FOR A PUBLIC HEARING
REGARDING A SOLID WASTE FACILITY PERMIT RENEWAL FOR A SOLID WASTE TRANSFER
STATION AND MATERIALS RECOVERY FACILITY**

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Solid & Hazardous Waste Management Program, hereby gives notice that it has tentatively approved a Solid Waste Facility Permit renewal application regarding the operation of the existing Republic Services of New Jersey, LLC d/b/a Midco Waste Systems Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Facility located at 92 Baekeland Avenue, Borough of Middlesex, Middlesex County, New Jersey.

The application for a Solid Waste Facility Permit renewal was submitted in accordance with the requirements established at N.J.A.C. 7:26-2. The facility is currently permitted to accept solid waste types ID 10 (Municipal waste), ID 13 (Bulky waste), ID 13C (Construction and demolition waste), ID 23 (Vegetative waste), ID 25 (Animal and food processing waste) and ID 27 (Dry industrial waste) and/or recyclable materials. The facility can accept a daily maximum of 600 tons of above noted waste types (excluding waste type ID 13C). In addition, the facility may accept a daily maximum of 120 tons of solid waste type ID 13C. The facility shall not accept more than 3600 tons of all approved waste types and/or recyclable materials in a week. The applicant has not requested any changes or modifications to the permitted operations.

The public comment period on the draft permit action begins on the date of the publication of this notice and will close within thirty (30) days of this publication. Any interested person may submit written comments during this period to the Department concerning the draft permit action to:

Notice is hereby given that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), Office of Coastal and Land Use Planning, has received the following Water Quality Management Plan site specific amendment requests pursuant to P.L. 2011, c.203 which was enacted on January 17, 2012. This legislation modifies some aspects of the Water Quality Management Planning Program for a period of two years. P.L. 2011, c.203 directs the Department to accept and process certain site specific amendment proposals despite the absence of a wastewater management plan in compliance with the Water Quality Management Plan rules. Pursuant to the provisions of the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), notices of amendment proposals and the Department's subsequent final action are to be published in the New Jersey Register (NJR). In accordance with P.L. 2011, c.203, notice of site specific amendments for projects or activities having a wastewater planning flow of less than 20,000 gallons per day (gpd) or being less than 100 acres in size is to be published in the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Bulletin.

Notice of site specific amendment proposals for changes in sewer service area designation, which may include new or expanded wastewater treatment facilities, are individually provided below.

PUBLIC NOTICE**

Take notice that pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., the Water Quality Management (WQM) Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15, and P.L. 2011, c. 203, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is seeking public comment on a proposed amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management (WQM) Plan. This amendment proposal, submitted by Mansfield Township, Burlington County, would modify the Mansfield Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) to expand the Mansfield Farms Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) sewer service area (SSA) by 61.09 acres on Block 3, Lots 5.01 and 10.01, and Block 4, Lots 6.01 and 7, in Mansfield Township, Burlington County. The Northern Mansfield STP currently serves this area; therefore, the amendment proposes to transfer the designated sewer service for this area from the Northern Mansfield STP to the Mansfield Farms STP. The Mansfield Farms STP operates under New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) permit number NJ0108120.

Adoption of the proposed amendment would allow for the construction of a proposed commercial development consisting of a 365,535 square foot (sq. ft.) retail commercial building, four restaurants with 1,072 total seats, one gas station with eight filling stations, an 80 seat fast food restaurant, a 4,769 sq. ft. mini market, four retention basins, and 2,095 parking spaces. The proposed project site, located on Block 3, Lots 5.01 and 10.01, and Block 4, Lots 6.01 and

7, in Mansfield Township, is bisected by Route 206 and is currently used as agricultural hay fields. The total projected wastewater flow, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3, is 76,750 gallons per day (gpd).

Originally, a proposed 700,000 sq. ft. retail development was to be served at this location by a new 70,000 gpd on-site discharge to groundwater treatment plant as proposed in the Mansfield Township WMP, which was adopted on November 20, 2012. See 45 N.J.R. 57(b). The site was designated in the WMP as the Northern Mansfield Service Area. It was discovered through testing and analyses that an on-site disposal system would be substantially limited in hydraulic capacity due to soil quality, and, thus, the development would require an alternative wastewater disposal location. An evaluation of alternative locations determined that the Mansfield Farms STP SSA was a viable wastewater disposal alternative for Northern Mansfield. As a result, this amendment proposal would transfer the previously adopted Northern Mansfield Service Area to the Mansfield Farms SSA.

This proposed amendment has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules at N.J.A.C. 7:15 and P.L. 2011, c.203.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1 to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, version 3.1. Areas identified by the Landscape Project as being suitable habitat for threatened and endangered species Ranks 3 (State threatened), 4 (State endangered), and 5 (Federal endangered or threatened) are not to be included in the proposed SSAs except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) through (h). Review of the project site has determined that no threatened or endangered species habitat exists on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2, areas mapped as Natural Heritage Priority Sites are not to be included in the proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) through (h). Review of the project site has determined that no Natural Heritage Priority Sites exist on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)3, the Department has determined there are no special water resource protection areas along Category One waters on the site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)4, areas mapped as wetlands pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:9A-1 and 13:9B-25 are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) through (h). In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e)2, a Letter of Interpretation, L.O.I. # 0318-02-0005.1 FWW080001, issued by the Department's Division of Land Use Regulation (DLUR) on October 31, 2008, was submitted to the Department, confirming the presence and boundaries of ordinary and intermediate resource value wetlands, requiring a 50-foot buffer. The 50 foot buffer is depicted on the site plans submitted with the proposed amendment. In compliance with the LOI, the proposed SSA excludes both the mapped wetlands and associated 50-foot buffer. This L.O.I. remains valid under the Permit Extension Act at N.J.A.C. 7:1B until June 30, 2015.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 5.25(h)1, the future needs of the sewer service area were evaluated to determine whether sufficient capacity exists at the Mansfield Farms STP to serve the proposed project.

Improvements to the Mansfield Farms STP (including but not limited to an increase in its treatment capacity and collection system improvements) will need to be made to ensure that it will be able to adequately serve the proposed project. This will require a modification to the Plant's NJPDES permit that will allow it to accept the additional wastewater flow. In addition, the New Jersey American Water Company will be required to submit a re-rating Treatment Works Approval application to the Department's Bureau of Construction and Connection Permits (BCCP) for the Plant to certify that it is able to meet the modified NJPDES permit limits at the higher permitted flow amount. BCCP may also require a Treatment Works Approval permit for other construction projects at the Plant in order to treat the proposed additional flow. A NJPDES application is expected to be submitted to the Department's Bureau of Nonpoint Pollution Control in 2 to 3 months.

Pursuant to P.L. 2011, c. 203, the Department, in consultation with the applicable wastewater management planning agency, may approve the inclusion of land within a sewer service area (SSA) notwithstanding that existing treatment works may not currently have the assured capacity to treat wastewater from such land without infrastructure improvements or permit modifications. Therefore, amendments to update a SSA may be approved if such actions are

compliant with the applicable sections of the WQM Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15) regardless of whether capacity has been fully assessed. Additional issues which may need to be addressed for any new or expanded wastewater treatment facility proposal include, but are not limited to, compliance with stormwater regulations, antidegradation, effluent limitations, water quality analysis, and exact locations and designs of future treatment works. Additionally, sewer service to any particular project is subject to contractual allocations between municipalities, authorities and/or private parties, and is not guaranteed by this amendment.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 5.25(h)3, an analysis of the water supply needs of the project was performed. The proposed commercial development will be provided public water by New Jersey American Water Company's Mount Holly Water System (Public Water System I.D. #0323001) within an existing allocation utilizing the confined Middle Potomac Raritan Magothy aquifer. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3, a comparison of the water demand calculated for the proposed project and the remaining firm water capacity of the Mount Holly Water System shows that the existing Mount Holly Water System has the available capacity to supply water to the proposed development. The location of the diversion is located at Route 206 and Mansfield Road East, and the water allocation permit number is 5378. A December 12, 2012, letter from the Department's Bureau of Water Allocation and Well Permitting directs the New Jersey American Water Company to provide sufficient water to meet the water supply requirements of the lots listed above for the proposed site in accordance with condition 5 of a 1997 Stipulation of Settlement entered into by New Jersey American Water Company, Mount Holly Water Company, and the Department.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)4, a project or activity's stormwater management is to be evaluated. The county and local governments are responsible for review and implementation of the Stormwater Management rules during their review and approval of proposed development. Mansfield Township has adopted stormwater management ordinance (2008-5) which comply with the performance standards of the Stormwater Management Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:8.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 5.25(h)5, riparian zones have been identified on the proposed project site as it is bordered to the north and south by Crystal Creek (FW2-NT) and its tributaries. Riparian zones or buffers are established along all surface waters, based on the surface water body's classification designated at N.J.A.C. 7:9B, under the following regulations: the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules, the Stormwater Management rules, and the Water Quality Management Planning rules. The required buffer width for Crystal Creek is 50 feet. A Flood Hazard Area and Riparian Zone Verification (0318-02-0005.2) was obtained from the Department's Division of Land Use Regulation (DLUR) on March 5, 2009, and site plans submitted with the proposed amendment depict 150 foot riparian buffers. Mansfield Township has adopted Ordinance No. 2012-3 to satisfy the Riparian Corridor Analysis and to ensure the protection of the riparian corridors along all perennial and intermittent streams. As required, the adopted ordinance establishes and protects Water Resource/Buffer Conservation Zones (stream corridor buffer) adjacent to New Jersey Surface Water Quality Standards designated waters (excluding man-made) and regulates development within those zones. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)5i, the Riparian Corridor Analysis has been satisfied by applying a 150 foot buffer to the applicable portions of Crystal Creek, the adoption of Ordinance 2012-3, and the exclusion of the buffer area from the proposed SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)6, new disturbance in areas with a steep slope is not permitted. There are no steep slopes on the proposed project site.

Approval of this amendment does not eliminate the need for any permits, approvals or certifications required by any other Federal, State, County or municipal review agency with jurisdiction over this project activity.

This notice is being given to inform the public that a plan amendment has been proposed for the Tri-County WQM Plan. All information related to the WQM Plan, and the proposed amendment is located at the Department, Division of Coastal and Land Use Planning, P.O. PUBLIC NOTICE**

Take notice that on _____, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act (WQPA), N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules at N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted an amendment to the Monmouth County Water Quality Management (WQM) Plan. This amendment, entitled “Riverside Center”, submitted on behalf of XXXIII Associates/Riverside Center, LLC, designates a 46.8 acre portion of Block 18, Lot 2.02 in Millstone Township, Monmouth County as a discharge to groundwater service area (SSA) of 19,999 gallons per day (gpd) to be served by on-site septic systems to serve a proposed 9 lot major subdivision. The subject property, located on the northern side of Route 33 about 1,000 feet east of the intersection with Jamesburg-Perrineville Road, totals 57.43 acres. 10.94 acres of the property are wetlands, wetlands buffers, and flood plain that will not be developed. Therefore, the proposed SSA would be 46.8 acres in order to accommodate the entire proposed development of 9 lots which would each range in size from 2.5 to 13.5 acres.

This application has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules that set the environmental standards to be applied to an amendment at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.18, N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25.

Pursuant to P.L. 2011, c. 203, the Department, in consultation with the applicable wastewater management planning agency, may approve the inclusion of land within a SSA notwithstanding that existing treatment works may not currently have the assured capacity to treat wastewater from such land without infrastructure improvements or permit modification. Therefore, amendments to modify a SSA may be approved if such actions are compliant with the applicable sections of the Water Quality Management Planning rule (N.J.A.C. 7:15) regardless of whether capacity has been fully assessed, however, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)1, the projected wastewater flow of the project has been evaluated. The proposed wastewater flow, as calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:9A-7.4 is 19,999 gpd. The proposed project will be required to meet the 10 parts per million (ppm) nitrate dilution requirement for the New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) permit that will allow for wastewater disposal via a new discharge to groundwater. A 19 acre portion of the neighboring Block 8, Lot 8.01 in Monroe Township, Middlesex County will be used for dilution purposes in order to meet the above referenced nitrate dilution requirement. Provisions of the above referenced NJPDES permit require the permittee to give written notification to the Department of any planned physical or operational alterations or additions to the permitted facility when the alteration is expected to result in a significant change in the permittee's discharge and/or residuals use or disposal practices; as well as notify the Department prior to any changes in ownership that require the transfer of the NJPDES permit. These requirements

are specified in the NJPDES rules at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-4.2, and N.J.A.C. 7:14A- 6.7; and N.J.A.C. 7:14A-16.2, respectively.

As outlined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, sewer service may only be provided to areas that are not identified as environmentally sensitive areas (ESAs), Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas, beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, ESAs are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands, alone or in combination. These areas are not included in the SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, version 3.1. Areas identified by the Landscape Project as being suitable habitat for threatened and endangered species Ranks 3 (State threatened) , 4 (State endangered), and 5 (Federal endangered or threatened) are not to be included in proposed SSAs except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h), or unless a site has undergone a site specific Habitat Suitability Determination prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.26 that found the site to be not suitable habitat, or pursuant with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(g)2, the Department determined the ESA is not critical to a population of endangered or threatened species the loss of which would decrease the likelihood of the survival or recovery of the identified species. Review of the project site has determined that no threatened or endangered species habitat exists on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2, areas mapped as Natural Heritage Priority Sites are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). Review of the project site has determined that no Natural Heritage Priority Sites exist on site.

A Riparian zone has been identified on the property. Riparian zones or buffers are established along all surface waters, based on the surface water body's classification designated at N.J.A.C. 7:9B, under the following regulations: the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules, the Stormwater Management rules, and the Water Quality Management Planning rules. The required buffer width for the Millstone River which is designated FW2-NT, is 50 feet. An April 26, 2006 Stream Encroachment Jurisdictional Flood Hazard Area Control Act letter from the Department's Division of Land Use Regulation states that a stream encroachment permit is not required as no grading is proposed in the floodplain.

In order to satisfy the Riparian Corridor Analysis, Millstone Township has adopted Ordinance No. 10-18 to satisfy the Riparian Corridor Analysis and to ensure the protection of the riparian corridors along all perennial and intermittent streams. As required, the adopted ordinance establishes and protects Water Resource/Buffer Conservation Zones ("stream corridor buffer") adjacent to New Jersey Surface Water Quality Standards designated waters (excluding man-made) and regulates development within those zones. The stream corridor buffers vary in width depending upon the water body's classification in the Surface Water Quality Standards at N.J.A.C. 7:9B-1.15. To become compliant, and in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)5i, the Riparian Corridor Analysis has been satisfied by applying the 50 foot buffer to the applicable portions of the Millstone River, the adoption of Ordinance 10-18 and exclusion of the buffer area from the SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)4, areas mapped as wetlands pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:9A-1 and 13:9B-25 are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e)2, Letter of Interpretation, L.O.I. # 0000-02-0039.3, issued by the Department on January 23, 2009 was submitted to the Department, confirming the presence and boundaries of ordinary and intermediate resource value wetlands, requiring a 50-foot buffer. The applicant has also received a Freshwater Wetlands General Permit No 11Water Quality Certification and Transition Area Waiver Averaging Plan (0000-02-0039.2 FWW070001 GP11 and FWW070004 TW1) on August 12, 2010. A Grant of Conservation Restriction/Easement for the transition area and adjacent wetland dated November 3, 2010 for the property was recorded with the Monmouth County Clerk's office on November 8, 2010. In compliance with the LOI, the SSA excludes both the mapped wetlands and associated 50-foot buffer.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)6, proposed development disturbance is not to be located in areas with steep slopes, defined as any slope greater than 20 percent. There are no steep slopes on the subject site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3 the water supply need for the proposed project has been evaluated. Water supply for the proposed development will be provided by 9 individual wells which withdraw water from the Englishtown and Upper Potomac-Raritan-Magothy Aquifers. A water use analysis indicates that based on the wastewater design flow, a water use registration will be sufficient for the project unless significant amounts of water will be needed for a use that will not discharge to the wastewater system, i.e. irrigation. All wells that are installed must be constructed in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:9D-2 et. seq.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)4, a project or activity's stormwater management is to be evaluated. However, P.L. 2011, c. 203 directs there be a presumption that an engineered subdivision or site plan is not required. Without such information a review and determination of compliance with the Stormwater Management rules (N.J.A.C. 7:8) is not possible. The county and local governments are responsible for review and implementation of the Stormwater Management rules during their review and approval of proposed development. Millstone Township has adopted stormwater management ordinance (No.14 APR) which comply with the performance standards of the Stormwater Management Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:8.

This amendment proposal was noticed in the Department Bulletin on November 6, 2013, Volume 37 Issue 21, pages 7-9, and no comments were received during the comment period.

Additional issues which may need to be addressed for any new or expanded wastewater treatment facility proposal include, but are not limited to, compliance with stormwater regulations, antidegradation, effluent limitations, water quality analysis, and exact locations and designs of future treatment works. Additionally, sewer service to any particular project is subject to contractual allocations between municipalities, authorities and/or private parties, and is not guaranteed by this amendment.

Approval of this amendment does not eliminate the need for any permits, approvals or certifications required by any Federal, State, County or municipal review agency with jurisdiction over this project/activity.

Comments on the draft document or a request that NJDEP hold a non-adversarial public hearing on the document must be submitted, in writing, to the individual specified below (refer to the accompanying table for the appropriate permitting bureau) during the public comment period, which closes either:

1. 30 calendar days after publication of the last newspaper notice when a notice is published in the DEP Bulletin *and* a newspaper(s); or
2. 30 calendar days after publication of the DEP Bulletin notice when a notice is published in the DEP Bulletin *only*.

All persons, including permittees who believe that any condition of NJDEP's tentative decision to issue these permit actions is inappropriate must raise all reasonable issues of concern and submit all arguments and factual materials supporting their position during the public comment period. Any request for a public hearing shall state the nature of the proposed issues to be raised in the hearing. A public hearing will be conducted if NJDEP determines there is a significant degree of public interest. If a public hearing is held, the public comment period is automatically extended through the close of the hearing.

The following permit actions for the towns include: the Bayonne City's NJPDES CSO Permit NJG0109240, East Newark Borough's NJPDES CSO Permit NJG0117846, Harrison Town's NJPDES CSO Permit NJG0108871, Jersey City's NJPDES CSO Permit NJG0108723, Newark City's NJPDES CSO Permit NJG0108758, North Bergen Township's NJPDES CSO Permit NJG0108898, Paterson City's NJPDES CSO Permit NJG0108880 and the Town of Kearny's NJPDES CSO Permit NJG0111244. The new NJPDES numbers will be NJ0109240, NJ0117846, NJ0108871, NJ0108723, NJ0108758, NJ0108898, NJ0108880 and NJ0111244, respectively, to authorize discharges from CSOs.

Combined Sewer Overflows are discharges from Combined Sewer Systems (CSS). CSSs are sewers that were designed many decades ago to collect rainwater and snowmelt runoff, domestic sewage, and industrial wastewater in the same pipe. CSSs are no longer permitted in New Jersey for new communities, but many older cities in the State continue to operate existing CSSs. Most of the time, the CSSs transport all wastewater to a sewage treatment plant, where it is treated and then discharged to a water body. However, during periods of rainfall or snowmelt, the wastewater volume in a CSS can exceed the hydraulic capacity of the sewer system or treatment plant. For this reason, CSSs were designed to overflow during these periods and discharge excess wastewater directly from CSOs to nearby streams, rivers, or other water bodies prior to reaching the sewage treatment plant.

NJDEP has historically been regulating the majority of discharges from CSOs through authorizations under a Master General Permit NJ0105023 and others through individual permits, consistent with the National Policy for CSO Controls, N.J.A.C. 7:14A-11.12 Appendix C. NJDEP has determined that it is more appropriate to regulate all CSO discharges under individual permits in order to address the site-specific regulatory requirements of each of the permittees and to promote better coordination of a Long Term Control Plan (LTCP) among all permittees contributing to the hydraulically connected systems.

Passaic Valley Sewerage Commissioners

The existing facility discharges treated and disinfected, domestic wastewater with industrial contribution into the Upper New York Harbor and Upper Newark Bay, classified as SE- 2 and SE-3 waters respectively. These water bodies are located within the NY/NJ Harbor Complex Basin and are both tributaries to the Lower New York Bay. The existing facility has a NJPDES flow value of 330 million gallons per day (MGD) on an annual average and currently discharges a monthly average flow of approximately 251 MGD on an annual average. This action proposes effluent limitations based on a flow of 369 MGD since the permit is authorizing increased loadings for some pollutants based on the facility conveying and treating wet weather flows.

Modification provisions as cited in the permit may be initiated in accordance with the provisions set forth in Part IV and upon written notification from the Department.

Bayonne City's CSOs

Bayonne City discharges combined sewage from thirty (30) CSO outfalls which have solids/floatables removal equipment installed just prior to the discharge. These CSO outfalls discharge into the Kill Van Kull, Upper New York Bay and Newark Bay. The Kill Van Kull and Newark Bay are classified as SE3(C2) waters and the Upper New York Bay is classified as SE2(C2). The receiving waterbodies are all located within the NY/NJ Harbor Basin.

East Newark Borough's CSO

East Newark Borough discharges combined sewage from one (1) CSO outfall which has solids/floatables removal equipment installed just prior to discharge. The CSO outfall discharges into the Passaic River which is classified as a SE3(C2) waters and is located within the NY/NJ Harbor Basin.

Harrison Town's CSOs

Harrison Town discharges combined sewage from seven (7) CSO outfalls which have solids/floatables removal equipment installed just prior to discharge. These CSO outfalls discharge into the Passaic River which is classified as a SE3(C2) water and is located within the NY/NJ Harbor Basin.

Jersey City's CSOs

Jersey City discharges combined sewage from twenty one (21) CSO outfalls which have solids/floatables removal equipment installed just prior to the discharge. These CSO outfalls discharge into the Penhorn Creek and the Hackensack River. The Penhorn Creek is classified as FW2-NT(C2) waters and the Hackensack River classified as SE2(C2) waters. The receiving waterbodies are located within the NY/NJ Harbor Basin.

Newark City's CSOs

Newark City discharges combined sewage from seventeen (17) CSO. Ten (10) outfalls have solids/floatables removal equipment installed just prior to the discharge. Of the remaining seven (7) CSO outfalls, construction is

underway to install solids/floatables removal equipment at three (3) CSO outfalls. The CSO outfalls discharge into the Passaic River and the Elizabeth Channel. The Passaic River and the Elizabeth Channel are classified as SE3(C2) waters and are located within the NY/NJ Harbor Basin.

North Bergen Township's CSOs

North Bergen Township discharges combined sewage from nine (9) CSO outfalls have solids/floatables removal equipment installed just prior to the discharge. These CSO outfalls discharge into Bellmans Creek, Cromakill Creek and Penhorn Creek. Bellmans Creek, Cromakill Creek and Penhorn Creek are classified as SE2(C2) waters and are located within the NY/NJ Harbor Basin.

Paterson City's CSOs

The City of Paterson discharges combined sewage from twenty three (23) CSO outfalls. Nineteen (19) of the twenty-three (23) outfalls have solids/floatables removal equipment installed just prior to discharge. All CSO outfalls discharge into the Passaic River which is classified as FW2-NT(C2) waters and is located in the NY/NJ Harbor Basin.

Town of Kearny's CSOs

The Town of Kearny discharges combined sewage from five (5) CSO outfalls which have solids/floatables removal equipment installed just prior to discharge. These CSO outfalls discharge into the Passaic River and the Lower Passaic River Unnamed Tributary (Frank's Creek). The Passaic River and the Lower Passaic River Unnamed Tributary (Frank's Creek) are classified as SE3(C2) waters and are located within the NY/NJ Harbor Basin.

These above mentioned draft NJPDES permit actions have been prepared for these facilities based on the administrative record filed at the NJDEP, 401 East State Street, Trenton, New Jersey 08625. Copies of the fact sheet which describes in more detail the principal facts and significant considerations examined during the preparation of the draft permit, and the draft permit are posted on NJDEP's website at <http://www.nj.gov/dep/dwq/cso.htm>.
