Permit Descriptions

CAFRA - A Coastal Area Facility Act permit is required to construct residential, commercial, public, transportation, utility and energy-related facilities in the coastal area as defined by the Act.

Federal Consistency Activity: Certain federal permits, not limited to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permits, require certification by the DEP prior to the issuance of the permit by the federal agency.

Flood Hazard Area: A Flood Hazard permit or verification is required for disturbances within the floodway or floodplain in areas regulated under the Flood Hazard Area Control Act.

Freshwater Wetlands: A Permit (Letters of Exemption, Letters of Interpretation, Statewide General Permit, Open Water Fill, Individual, Transition Area Waiver, Water Quality Certificate) is needed prior to engaging in a regulated activity in or around freshwater wetlands and associated transition areas. A Flood Hazard Area Permit, an U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredge and Fill Permit, and a Water Quality Certification may also be required.

General Groundwater Petroleum Products Cleanup: This general permit authorizes the surface water discharge of treated groundwater previously contaminated with petroleum products.

NJPDES permits: A permit is required for the discharge of pollutants to surface and groundwater, a discharge from an indirect user or the land application of municipal and/or industrial residuals. (A more comprehensive definition of activities, which require a permit, may be found at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-2.4)

Solid Waste Facility: A permit is required to conduct or operate any solid waste facility as defined under the Solid Waste Management Act, N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et seq., and N.J.A.C. 7:26-1 et seq.

Highlands Resource: A Highland Preservation Area Approval is required for regulated activities within the Highland Preservation Area as defined in the Highlands Water Protection & Planning Act Preservation Area Rules. Highlands Applicability Determinations verifies certain exemptions allowed by the regulations.

Tidal Wetlands: A Coastal Wetlands Permit is needed to excavate, dredge, fill or erect structures on coastal wetlands.

Treatment Works Approval: A TWA permit is required for the construction, modification or operation of a treatment works, including sanitary/industrial sewage pretreatment or treatment systems, sewage conveyance systems, sewer extensions and subsurface sewage disposal systems.

Waterfront Development: A permit is required for any project involving the development of waterfront near or upon any tidal or navigable waterway in the State.

Coastal Wetlands: A permit authorizing disturbances to Mapped Tidal Wetlands under the Wetlands Act of 1970, N.J.S.A. 13:9A”

General Information

The DEP Bulletin is an information service provided by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. In compliance with the Rules and Regulations Governing 90 Day Construction Permits (NJAC 7:1C-1.1 et seq.) this semi-monthly publication contains a list of construction permit applications recently filed or acted upon by the DEP. Using the Application Milestone Codes located on the inside front cover, interested persons can determine the status of Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permits, Federal Consistency Activity permits, Freshwater Wetlands Individual and Statewide General permits, General Groundwater Petroleum Products Cleanup permits, Open Water Fill permits, Solid Waste Facility permits (SWF), Flood Hazard Area (FHA) permits, Tidal Wetlands permits, Waterfront Development permits and Treatment Works Approvals (TWA). In addition, this publication lists status of Highlands application and Highlands Applicability Determinations.

In addition, a calendar of Events of Interest and a Schedule of Public Hearings is provided. The public hearings listed do not, however, constitute an official notice. Environmental Impact Statements acted upon during the period are also shown. Additional information concerning the permit applications can be obtained by calling the project manager at the appropriate office listed on the inside back cover.

Public Hearings are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide or of broad general interest and open to the public.

Contested Case Hearings are held between the State and a particular party involving an application, enforcement violation or an appeal. Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

DEP Events of Public Interest include public hearings, council meetings, workshops, public information meetings, and exams.

**Notice Regarding Adoption of Site Specific Water Quality Management Plan Amendment Applications
Pursuant to P.L.2013, c.188**

Notice is hereby given that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), Office of Coastal and Land Use Planning, has adopted the following Water Quality Management Plan site specific amendment requests pursuant to P.L. 2013, c.188 which was enacted on January 15, 2014. This legislation modifies some aspects of the Water Quality Management Planning Program for a period of two years. P.L. 2013, c.188 directs the Department to accept and process certain site specific amendment proposals despite the absence of a wastewater management plan in compliance with the Water Quality Management Plan rules. Pursuant to the provisions of the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), notices of amendment proposals and the Department's subsequent final action are to be published in the New Jersey Register (NJR). In accordance with P.L. 2013, c.188, notice of adoption of site specific amendments for projects or activities having a wastewater planning flow of less than 50,000 gallons per day (gpd) or being less than 100 acres in size is to be published in the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Bulletin.

Notice(s) of adoption of site specific amendment(s) for changes in sewer service area designation, which may include new or expanded wastewater treatment facilities, are individually provided below:

Adopted Amendment to the Ocean County Water Quality Management Plan

**Toms River Affordable Apartments
Public Notice**

Take notice that on May 12, 2015, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Ocean County WQMP was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This amendment, entitled "Toms River Senior Affordable Apartments", submitted on behalf of Toms River Township, expands the Ocean County Utilities Authority (OCUA) sewer service area (SSA) to allow for the construction of an apartment complex. This amendment has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules at N.J.A.C. 7:15 and P.L 2013, c.188. This notice represents the Department's determination that the amendment is in compliance with the regulatory criteria pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15.

The proposed project site is located in Toms River Township, Ocean County on Block 166, Lots 2 and 10. This amendment would allow for the construction of 102 age-restricted apartment units with a total of 94 one-bedroom apartments, 8 two-bedroom apartments, and a clubhouse/rental office on the above referenced parcel. The projected wastewater flow for the proposed new development, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3, is 12,227.5 gallons per day (gpd).

The currently adopted SSA excludes a significant portion of the above referenced property due to the presence of a Special Water Resource Protection Area (300-foot buffer) on the Slab Branch, a Category One Tributary to the Toms River, which had been mapped as being located on the property. A site investigation by the Department's Division of Land Use Regulation (DLUR) on August 19, 2014 determined that the Slab Branch does not, in fact, exist on the property and had been mapped incorrectly. The report found that the Slab Branch actually terminates south of the proposed project site. On October 3, 2014 DLUR issued a Flood Hazard Applicability Determination ("jurisdictional determination"), under file No. 1507-11-0006.1 APD 140001 for the proposed project. This determination stated that:

“...the Department has determined that the proposed project activities are located outside of the assumed flood hazard area and riparian zone of the nearest regulated waterway (a tributary to the Toms River named Slab Branch). Therefore, the formal authorization for the proposed project is not required under the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules.”

While the field verified location of the Slab Branch is not located on the property, a portion of its 300 foot buffer area still extends partially onto the proposed project site. This area will still remain excluded from the SSA. No sewage producing structures are proposed for this portion of the property.

Of the total 11.9 acres that comprise Block 166, Lot 2 and 10, the portion proposed to be added to the SSA is 1.9 acres specifically on Block 166, Lot 10. A 3.61 acre tree conservation area, a wetlands, a wetlands buffer area and the above referenced 300 foot riparian buffer will remain outside of the SSA. These areas may be subject to a conservation deed restriction to meet mitigation requirements for impacts to critical wildlife habitat.

As outlined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(a), sewer service may only be provided to areas that are not identified as environmentally sensitive areas (ESAs), Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas, beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b), ESAs are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands, alone or in combination. Aside from a portion of the 300 foot buffer associated with the Slab Branch that extends partially onto the proposed project site, as noted above, and wetlands, there are no other environmentally sensitive areas identified on the parcel. These environmentally sensitive areas are not included in the SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, version 3.1. Areas identified by the Landscape Project as being suitable habitat for threatened and endangered species Ranks 3 (State threatened), 4 (State endangered), and 5 (Federal endangered or threatened) are not to be included in proposed SSAs except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h), or unless a site has undergone a site specific Habitat Suitability Determination prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.26 that found the site to be not suitable habitat, or pursuant with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(g)2, the Department determined the ESA is not critical to a population of endangered or threatened species the loss of which would decrease the likelihood of the survival or recovery of the identified species. Review of the project site has determined that no threatened or endangered species habitat exists on site.

The Department also reviewed Critical Wildlife Habitat (CWH) as part of a CAFRA permit review in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:7E-3.39. CWH are specific areas known to serve an essential role in maintaining wildlife, particularly in wintering, breeding and migrating. The Department considers patches of woody vegetation along the Atlantic seaboard to serve a critical role in providing resting and foraging habitat for migratory birds. Within the coastal zone mainland, patches of woody vegetation equivalent to 20 acres in size, and greater, function as migratory bird stopover habitat.

The proposed project site is located within a large woodland complex that was determined to be in excess of 20 acres through an analysis of current aerial photography and Land Use Land Cover mapping. As a result, the associated woody community exceeds the minimum patch size identified as a characteristic of migratory songbird habitat and the applicant must conduct mitigation to offset their impact on CWH. The Department has determined that the applicant may possibly be able to address CWH mitigation needs entirely onsite. The placement of a conservation deed restriction on the above referenced tree preservation area as well as the wetlands, wetlands buffer areas, and riparian buffer area, would result in adequate onsite mitigation for the direct loss of 3.5 acres of CWH, as described in condition 6 of the applicant's CAFRA permit that has been issued by the Department on April 2, 2015.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2, areas mapped as Natural Heritage Priority Sites are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). Review of the project site has determined that no Natural Heritage Priority Sites exist on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)3, areas identified as special water resource protection areas along Category One waterways and their tributaries are not to be included in SSA's, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). As stated above, while the field verified location of the Slab Branch is not located on the property, a portion of its 300 foot buffer area still extends partially onto the proposed project site. This area will remain excluded from the sewer service area and no sewage producing structures are proposed for this portion of the property.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)4, areas mapped as wetlands pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:9A-1 and 13:9B-25 are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e)2, a Letter of Interpretation: Line Verification File # 1507-11-0006.1, FWW140003, a Freshwater Wetlands General Permit #11 FWW140001 and a Wetlands Transition Area Waiver Averaging Plan FWW140002 have been approved by the Department, confirming that the extent of wetlands and transition area are accurately delineated on the proposed project activity site and confirming that the proposed project meets the requirements for approval to disturb regulated areas pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:7A-4.3, 5.11, 6.2 and 13.1. The provisions at N.J.A.C 7:15-5.24(b)4, have been satisfied by the exclusion of the wetlands areas from the proposed SSA.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(c), certain coastal planning areas, not applicable here, must also be excluded from SSA. Specifically, there are no Coastal Fringe Planning Areas, Coastal Rural Planning Areas, or Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Areas on the project site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, areas with Federal 201 grant limitations that prohibit the extension of sewers are excluded from the adopted SSA either where local mapped information exists delineating these areas, or through a narrative description where mapping does not exist, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(f)1. Pre-existing grant conditions and requirements (from Federal and State grants or loans for sewerage facilities), which provide for restriction of sewer service to environmentally sensitive areas, are unaffected by adoption of these amendments.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, there are other special restricted areas, which must also be excluded from SSA pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)2 through 4. None of those special restricted areas are applicable here. Specifically, there are no beaches, coastal high hazard areas, or dunes on the project site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)1, the projected wastewater flow of the project has been evaluated. The Department has determined that the OCUA Central Wastewater Pollution Control Facility has adequate available capacity to treat the proposed wastewater flow from this project. The projected wastewater flow for the proposed new development, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3, is 12,227.5 gallons per day (gpd). Currently the OCUA Central WPCF (NJ0029408) is permitted to discharge up to 32 Million Gallons per day (MGD) of treated wastewater to the Atlantic Ocean. Based on an average of the monthly average flow for the most recent twelve month period for which discharge monitoring data is available, the existing wastewater flow discharged from the OCUA Central WPCF was calculated to be 21.55 MGD. The addition of the proposed development's projected wastewater flow would not cause the wastewater generation potential of the expanded SSA to exceed the permitted capacity of the OCUA Central WPCF.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3 the water supply need for the proposed project has been evaluated. Water supply for the proposed development will be provided by the United Water Toms River which is a public water system which withdraws water from the Kirkwood Cohansey and Atlantic City 800 foot Sands Aquifers. The location of the diversion is Toms River and the water allocation permit numbers are 5000 and 5001. The existing water allocation permits will not require modification to serve the proposed project. United Water Toms River is currently permitted under PWSID No. 1507005 to allocate 734.35 million gallons per month (MGM) and has a water supply surplus of 113.927 MGM. The proposed water demand of the project, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(f)1i, is 0.402 MGM; therefore sufficient water supply is available to serve the proposed development within the existing water allocation permit.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)4, a project or activity's stormwater management is to be evaluated. However, P.L. 2013, c. 188 directs that there is a presumption that an engineered subdivision or site plan is not required. Without such information a review and determination of compliance with the Stormwater Management rules (N.J.A.C. 7:8) is not possible. The county and local governments are responsible for review and implementation of the

Stormwater Management rules during their review and approval of proposed development. Toms River Township has an adopted stormwater management ordinance (No. 4060-06) which complies with the performance standards of the Stormwater Management Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:8.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)5, the proposed project is not located in the riparian zone. As noted above, a portion of the 300 foot buffer associated with the Slab Branch extends partially onto the proposed project site. This area will still remain excluded from the SSA. No sewage producing structures are proposed for this portion of the property.

A Riparian buffer zone, as described above has been identified on the property. Riparian zones or buffers are established along all surface waters, based on the surface water body's classification designated at N.J.A.C. 7:9B, under the following regulations: the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules, the Stormwater Management rules, and the Water Quality Management Planning rules. To become compliant, and in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)5i, the Riparian Corridor Analysis has been satisfied by applying the 300 foot buffer to the applicable portions of the Slab Branch, and the exclusion of the buffer area from the proposed SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)6, proposed development disturbance is not to be located in areas with steep slopes, defined as any slope greater than 20 percent. There are no steep slopes on the subject site.

This amendment proposal was noticed in the DEP Bulletin on February 18, 2015 at Volume 39, Issue 4, pages 7-12 and no comments were received during the comment period.

Additional issues which may need to be addressed for any new or expanded wastewater treatment facility proposal include, but are not limited to, compliance with stormwater regulations, antidegradation, effluent limitations, water quality analysis, and exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules. Additionally, sewer service to any particular project is subject to contractual allocations between municipalities, authorities and/or private parties, and is not guaranteed by this amendment.

**Adopted Amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP)
Bancroft Neurohealth
Public Notice**

Take notice that on May 12, 2015, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County WQMP was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This amendment proposal, submitted by Dewberry Engineers, Inc. on behalf of Bancroft, expands the sewer service area (SSA) of the Mount Laurel Municipal Utilities Authority, Hartford Road Water Pollution Control Facility (permitted under NJ0025178) to include a portion of Block 509, Lot 1.04, in Mount Laurel Township, Burlington County. This proposal is named "Bancroft Neurohealth Facility".

The amendment has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-1 et seq and Section 6(h) of P.L. 2011, c. 203, as amended and supplemented P.L. 2013, c. 188, which allows for the consideration of an application for a WQMP amendment for a proposed activity that delineates as SSA a parcel, not to exceed 100 acres in size, that had been previously included in a formerly adopted SSA, provided it can be demonstrated with the use of updated or more accurate information that the parcel complies with the regulatory criteria for the delineation of a SSA established at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, environmentally sensitive areas (ESAs) have been assessed to determine what areas of the project are appropriate for inclusion in the proposed SSA. ESAs evaluated include, but are not limited to: habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, riparian zones, wetlands, steep slopes, Coastal

Fringe, Coastal Rural and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas, beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, ESAs are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands, alone or in combination. These ESAs are not included in the adopted SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, version 3.1. Areas identified by the Landscape Project as being suitable habitat for threatened and endangered species Ranks 3 (State threatened) , 4 (State endangered), and 5 (Federal endangered or threatened) are not to be included in proposed SSAs except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h), or unless a site has undergone a site specific Habitat Suitability Determination prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.26 that found the site to be not suitable habitat, or pursuant with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(g)2, the Department determined the ESA is not critical to a population of endangered or threatened species the loss of which would decrease the likelihood of the survival or recovery of the identified species. Review of the project site has determined that no threatened or endangered species habitat exists on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2, areas mapped as Natural Heritage Priority Sites are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). Review of the project site has determined that no Natural Heritage Priority Sites exist on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)3, C1 special water resource protection areas are not to be included in the proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) - (h). No C1 waterways are within 300 feet of the project site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(c), lands within certain coastal planning areas (Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural, and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas) are not included in the SSA. The project site is not in a coastal planning area.

All other special restricted areas as defined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1-4; areas with Federal 201 grant limitations that prohibit the extension of sewers to serve development in specified areas such as wetlands and floodplains; and beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes are not applicable to the amendment's site location.

This amendment proposal, submitted by Dewberry Engineers, Inc. on behalf of Bancroft, expands the sewer service area (SSA) of the Mount Laurel Municipal Utilities Authority, Hartford Road Water Pollution Control Facility (permitted under NJ0025178) to include a portion of Block 509, Lot 1.04, in Mount Laurel Township, Burlington County. This proposal is named “Bancroft Neurohealth Facility”.

The amendment has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-1 et seq and Section 6(h) of P.L. 2011, c. 203, as amended and supplemented P.L. 2013, c. 188, which allows for the consideration of an application for a WQMP amendment for a proposed activity that delineates as SSA a parcel, not to exceed 100 acres in size, that had been previously included in a formerly adopted SSA, provided it can be demonstrated with the use of updated or more accurate information that the parcel complies with the regulatory criteria for the delineation of a SSA established at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, environmentally sensitive areas (ESAs) have been assessed to determine what areas of the project are appropriate for inclusion in the proposed SSA. ESAs evaluated include, but are not limited to: habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, riparian zones, wetlands, steep slopes, Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas, beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, ESAs are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands, alone or in combination. These ESAs are not included in the adopted SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife’s Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, version 3.1. Areas identified by the Landscape Project as being suitable habitat for threatened and endangered species Ranks 3 (State threatened), 4 (State endangered), and 5 (Federal endangered or threatened) are not to be included in proposed SSAs except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h), or unless a site has undergone a site specific Habitat Suitability Determination prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.26 that found the site to be not suitable habitat, or pursuant with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(g)2, the Department determined the ESA is not critical to a population of endangered or threatened species the loss of which would decrease the likelihood of the survival or recovery of the identified species. Review of the project site has determined that no threatened or endangered species habitat exists on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2, areas mapped as Natural Heritage Priority Sites are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). Review of the project site has determined that no Natural Heritage Priority Sites exist on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)3, C1 special water resource protection areas are not to be included in the proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) - (h). No C1 waterways are within 300 feet of the project site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)4, areas mapped as wetlands pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:9A-1 and 13:9B-25 are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). In accordance with

N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e)2, Letter of Interpretation, L.O.I. # 0324-02-0019.1-FWW080002 was submitted, which re-delineates the wetlands and their associated transition areas, and these areas are not included in the adopted SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(c), lands within certain coastal planning areas (Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural, and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas) are not included in the SSA. The project site is not in a coastal planning area.

All other special restricted areas as defined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1-4; areas with Federal 201 grant limitations that prohibit the extension of sewers to serve development in specified areas such as wetlands and floodplains; and beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes are not applicable to the amendment's site location.

The proposal for this amendment was noticed in the New Jersey Bulletin on April 1, 2015 at Volume 39, Issue 7, and no comments were received during the comment period.

Take notice that on April 13, 2015, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Monmouth County WQMP was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This amendment, entitled "Harms and Pinnacle Sewer Service Area", submitted on behalf of Howell Township, expands the Manasquan River Regional Sewerage Authority MRRSA sewer service area (SSA) by 84.8 acres to allow for the construction of 57 single family homes and the connection of 3 existing single family homes to the MRRSA. This amendment has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules at N.J.A.C. 7:15 and P.L. 2013, c.188. This notice represents the Department's determination that the proposed amendment is in compliance with the regulatory criteria pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15.

The proposed project site is located in Howell Township, Monmouth County on portions of Block 130, Lots 17, 20-22, 57-61. This amendment would allow for the construction of 57 single family homes and the connection of 3 existing single family homes to MRRSA, on the above referenced parcels. The projected wastewater flow for the proposed new development and existing homes, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3, is 18,000 gallons per day (gpd).

As outlined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(a), sewer service may only be provided to areas that are not identified as environmentally sensitive areas (ESAs), Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas, beaches, coastal high hazard areas, and dunes.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b), ESAs are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas, and wetlands, alone or in combination. These areas are not included in the proposed SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, version 3.1. Areas identified by the Landscape Project as being suitable habitat for threatened and endangered species Ranks 3 (State threatened), 4 (State endangered), and 5 (Federal endangered or threatened) are not to be included in proposed SSAs except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h), or unless a site has undergone a site specific Habitat Suitability Determination prepared in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.26 that found the site to be not suitable habitat, or pursuant with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(g)2, the Department determined the ESA is not critical to a population of endangered or threatened species the loss of which would decrease the likelihood of the survival or recovery of the identified species. Review of the project site has determined that no threatened or endangered species habitat exists on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)2, areas mapped as Natural Heritage Priority Sites are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). Review of the project site has determined that no Natural Heritage Priority Sites exist on site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)3, areas identified as special water resource protection areas along Category One waterways and their tributaries are not to be included in SSA's, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). The Department has determined there are no special water resource protection areas along Category One waters on the site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)4, areas mapped as wetlands pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:9A-1 and 13:9B-25 are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e) – (h). In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(e)2, a Letter of Interpretation (LOI): Line Verification File # 1319-06-0036.1, FWW060001, a Freshwater Wetlands General Permit #1 and Transition Area Waiver FWW060002-FWGP1 issued by the Department on July 19, 2007 was submitted to the Department, confirming that the extent of wetlands and transition area are accurately delineated on the proposed project activity site and confirming that the proposed project meets the requirements for approval to disturb regulated areas pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:7A-4.3, 5.11, 6.2 and 13.1. The above mentioned approvals remain valid under the Permit Extension Act at N.J.A.C. 7:1B until June 30, 2015. The provisions at N.J.A.C 7:15-5.24(b)4, have been satisfied by the exclusion of the wetlands areas from the proposed SSA.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(c), certain coastal planning areas, not applicable here, must also be excluded from SSA. Specifically, there are no Coastal Fringe Planning Areas, Coastal Rural Planning Areas, or Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Areas on the project site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, areas with Federal 201 grant limitations that prohibit the extension of sewers are excluded from the adopted SSA either where local mapped information exists delineating these areas, or through a narrative description in a wastewater management plan where mapping does not exist, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(f)1. Pre-existing grant conditions and requirements (from Federal and State grants or loans for sewerage facilities), which provide for restriction of sewer service to environmentally sensitive areas are unaffected by adoption of these amendments.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, there are other special restricted areas, which must also be excluded from SSA pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)2 through 4. None of those special restricted areas are applicable here. Specifically, there are no beaches, coastal high hazard areas, or dunes on the project site.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)1, the projected wastewater flow of the project has been evaluated. The Department has determined that the OCUA Northern Wastewater Pollution Control Facility has adequate available capacity to treat the proposed wastewater flow from this project. The projected wastewater flow for the proposed new development, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3 is 18,000 gallons per day (gpd). Currently the OCUA Northern WPCF (NJ0028142) is permitted to discharge up to 32 Million Gallons per day (MGD) of treated wastewater to the Atlantic Ocean. Based on an average of the monthly average flow for the most recent twelve month period for which discharge monitoring data is available, the existing wastewater flow discharged from the OCUA Northern WPCF was calculated to be 22.27 MGD. The addition of the proposed development's projected wastewater

flow would not cause the wastewater generation potential of the expanded SSA to exceed the permitted capacity of the OCUA Central WPCF.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3 the water supply need for the proposed project has been evaluated. Water supply for the proposed development will be provided by the New Jersey American Water Company which is a public water system which withdraws water from the Manasquan Reservoir. The location of the diversion is on Georgia Tavern Road in Howell Township and the water allocation permit number is WAP090002. The existing water allocation permit will not require modification to serve the proposed project. It is currently permitted under PWSID No. 1345001 to allocate 2,539.58 million gallons per month (MGM) and has a water supply surplus of 247.05 MGM. The proposed water demand of the project, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(f)1i, is 2.133 MGM; therefore sufficient water supply is available to serve the proposed development within the existing water allocation permit.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)4, a project or activity's stormwater management is to be evaluated. However, P.L. 2013, c. 188 directs that there is a presumption that an engineered subdivision or site plan is not required. Without such information a review and determination of compliance with the Stormwater Management rules (N.J.A.C. 7:8) is not possible. The county and local governments are responsible for review and implementation of the Stormwater Management rules during their review and approval of proposed development. Howell Township has an adopted stormwater management ordinance (No.0-08-31) which complies with the performance standards of the Stormwater Management Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:8.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 5.25(h)5, riparian zones are not to be included in proposed SSAs, except as provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)i-vii. Riparian zones or buffers are established along all surface waters, based on the surface water body's classification designated at N.J.A.C. 7:9B, under the following regulations: the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules, the Stormwater Management rules, and the Water Quality Management Planning rules. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)5, the proposed project site is not located in a riparian zone.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)6, proposed development disturbance is not to be located in areas with steep slopes, defined as any slope greater than 20 percent. There are no steep slopes on the subject site.

This amendment proposal was noticed in the DEP Bulletin on February 18, 2015 at Volume 39, Issue 4, pages 14-17 and no comments were received during the comment period.

Additional issues which may need to be addressed for any new or expanded wastewater treatment facility or other specific project may include, but are not limited to, the following: compliance with stormwater regulations; antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.

Pike Run Plaza

Take notice that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is seeking public comment on a proposed amendment (PI# 435434; Activity# AMD150002) to the Upper Raritan Water Quality Management (WQM) Plan. This proposed amendment will also modify the Somerset County Future Wastewater Service Area (FWSA) Map for that portion of the County within the Upper Raritan WQM Planning Area. This proposed amendment would provide for the construction of a portion of the proposed Pike Run Plaza commercial development project, to be located on the site formerly to be utilized as the U.S. Route 206 Bypass Right of Way (Bypass ROW). The 7.89 acre parcel, where the Bypass ROW was to be located, is at the intersection of Belle Mead Griggstown Road and U.S. Route 206, known locally as Van Horne Road in Montgomery Township, Somerset County.

The area of the former Bypass ROW is now to be a component of the mixed use development plan proposed by Country Club Meadows, LLC, consisting of several larger parcels located in the northern portion of Montgomery Township known as Belle Mead. As part of the site plan approval process for the Country Club Meadows development plan, the area of the former Bypass ROW is to be reconfigured as a new lot. The proposed site of the Pike Run Plaza is to encompass an existing parcel; Block 5023, Lot 2 and the new lot to be created from the former Bypass ROW area.

As identified on the Somerset County FWSA Map, adopted on January 24, 2013 all parcels to be incorporated in the Country Club Meadows, LLC development plan, with the exception of the property located on the former Bypass ROW, is designated as the sewer service area (SSA) to the Pike Brook Sanitary Treatment Plant (NJPDES# NJ0060038). As part of this proposed amendment, the former area for the Bypass ROW is proposed to be included as SSA to allow for the proposed construction of Pike Run Plaza commercial development.

Based on the current conceptual design plan, the total projected wastewater flow to be generated from the entire commercial development within the Pike Run Plaza project property, calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A, is approximately 19,750 gallons per day (gpd). This estimated wastewater flow includes any potential wastewater generated from the proposed development to lie within the former Bypass ROW. Potable water for the proposed development is to be provided by New Jersey American Water (NJAW).

This proposed amendment has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and 5.25(h) and Public Law (P.L.) 2013, c.188. This preliminary notice represents the Department's determination that the proposed amendment is in compliance with the regulatory criteria pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and 5.25.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b), environmentally sensitive areas have been assessed to determine what areas are appropriately included in the proposed SSA. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, environmentally sensitive areas are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger, alone or in combination, consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas (riparian buffer), and wetlands. These environmentally sensitive areas are not included in the proposed sewer service area except as noted below.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species (Landscape Project), version 3.1. A review of the Landscape Project indicates no threatened or endangered species habitat is identified within the proposed new SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and 5.25, no portion of the proposed development on site is identified as within a Natural Heritage Priority Site, the riparian buffer associated with C1 water, or wetlands.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, areas with Federal 201 grant limitations prohibited from extension of sewers and excluded from the proposed SSA are not applicable to this proposed amendment. Furthermore, all other ESA as defined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(c) 1-3; lands within certain coastal planning areas (Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural, and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas) are not applicable to this proposed amendment location nor are any ESA as defined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d) 1-4; beaches, coastal high hazards area or dunes as defined under N.J.A.C.7:7E.

Montgomery Township, Somerset County, New Jersey has adopted “The Code of the Township of Montgomery” containing stormwater control and design measures at Sub-Chapter No. §16-5.2. The Department has determined that this sub-chapter/ ordinance complies with the water quality and quantity standards in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:8. Consequently, the requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(g)1 for stormwater control have been satisfied.

No portion of the proposed development on site is identified as within a riparian zone as established at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(g)2-5 or areas with a steep slope as required at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(g)6.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3, the Department evaluated the water supply availability for the proposed project. Potable water to the proposed development is to be supplied by the NJAW, Raritan System (PWSID# 2004002) which has an identified available surplus capacity of approximately 979 million gallons per month. Therefore, the Department determined there is sufficient water supply available within the existing water allocation permit to serve the proposed new on-site development.

This proposed amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues may need to be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: compliance with stormwater regulations; antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.

This notice is being given to inform the public that a plan amendment has been proposed for the Upper Raritan WQM Plan. All information relating to the WQM Plan and the proposed amendment is located at the Department’s, Office of Water Resource Management (WRM) Coordination, P.O. As identified on the Somerset County FWSA Map, adopted on January 24, 2013, the existing wastewater generating structures located within the TNGC property are designated as the sewer service area (SSA) of the permitted on-site discharge to ground water treatment facility (DGW), Trump National STP (NJPDES #NJ0142883). As part of this proposed amendment, the area for the proposed paddle tennis facility is to be included as SSA of the Trump National STP to allow for the proposed construction of this new building. Potable water for the TNGC is provided by individual on-site non-public water wells.

As calculated in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3, the Trump National STP is permitted to discharge up to 29,631 gallons per day (gpd). A portion of this wastewater flow, 6,750 gpd, is attributed from golf rounds for 450 club members; with a peak wastewater projection assuming all 450 members golfed on the same day. The Department has determined, at any given time, club members would only participate in either golf rounds or utilize the proposed paddle tennis courts, therefore no expansion or adjustment of the existing approved permitted flow is necessary to accommodate this new facility. However the SSA of the TNGC STP will be expanded to allow for the footprint of development of the new construction.

This proposed amendment has been reviewed in accordance with the Water Quality Management Planning rules at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and 5.25(h) and Public Law (P.L.) 2013, c.188. This preliminary notice represents the Department's determination that the proposed amendment is in compliance with the regulatory criteria pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and 5.25.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b), environmentally sensitive areas have been assessed to determine what areas are appropriately included in the proposed SSA. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24, environmentally sensitive areas are defined as contiguous areas of 25 acres or larger, alone or in combination, consisting of habitat for threatened and endangered species as identified on the Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species, Natural Heritage Priority Sites, Category One (C1) special water resource protection areas (riparian buffer), and wetlands. These environmentally sensitive areas are not included in the proposed sewer service area except as noted below.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(b)1, to determine areas designated as threatened or endangered species habitat, the Department utilized the Division of Fish and Wildlife's Landscape Project Maps of Habitat for Endangered, Threatened or Other Priority Species (Landscape Project), version 3.1. A review of the Landscape Project indicates no threatened or endangered species habitat is identified within the proposed new SSA.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24 and 5.25, no portion of the proposed development on site is identified as within a Natural Heritage Priority Site, the riparian buffer associated with C1 water, or wetlands.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d)1, areas with Federal 201 grant limitations prohibited from extension of sewers and excluded from the proposed SSA are not applicable to this proposed amendment. Furthermore, all other ESA as defined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(c) 1-3; lands within certain coastal planning areas (Coastal Fringe, Coastal Rural, and Coastal Environmentally Sensitive Planning Areas) are not applicable to this proposed amendment location nor are any ESA as defined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.24(d) 1-4; beaches, coastal high hazards area or dunes as defined under N.J.A.C.7:7E.

Bedminster Township, Somerset County, New Jersey has adopted municipal ordinance (Ord. #05-40, §2) containing stormwater control and design measures. The Department has determined that this ordinance complies with the water quality and quantity standards in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:8. Consequently, the requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(g)1 for stormwater control have been satisfied.

No portion of the proposed new development on site is identified as within a riparian zone as established at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(g)2-5 or areas with a steep slope as required at N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(g)6.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.25(h)3, the Department evaluated the water supply availability for the proposed project. The TNGC currently holds an existing water allocation permit (No. 2527P) for a total water allocation of 19.4 million gallons/month for both potable water and irrigation. Potable water obtained from groundwater withdrawals under this permit is utilized to support all on-site amenities. The total water supply needs for the TNGC site, projected based on the wastewater design flow is approximately 30,000 gpd. As the portion of this total wastewater projected at this site is calculated based on the total club membership, and the indoor paddle tennis facility will be used by members, no new wastewater has been included for this new structure. Therefore, there is no new water demand as result of the proposed additional use for the paddle tennis building.

This proposed amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues may need to be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: compliance with stormwater regulations; antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.

This notice is being given to inform the public that a plan amendment has been proposed for the Upper Raritan WQM Plan. All information relating to the WQM Plan and the proposed amendment is located at the Department's, Office of Water Resource Management (WRM) Coordination, P.O. Box 420, Mail Code 401-02A, 401 East State Street, Trenton, N.J. 08625-0420. The Department's file is available for inspection between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. An appointment to inspect the documents may be arranged by calling the Office of WRM Coordination at (609) 777-4349.

Interested persons may submit written comments on the amendment to WQM Program Docket, Office of WRM Coordination at the Department address cited above with a copy sent to Mr. Robert C. All comments must be submitted within 30 days of the date of this published notice. All comments submitted prior to the close of the comment period shall be considered by the Department in reviewing the amendment request.

Interested persons may request in writing that the Department hold a non-adversarial public hearing on the amendment or extend the public comment period in this notice up to 30 additional days. These requests must state the nature of the issues to be raised at the proposed hearing or state the reasons why the proposed extension is necessary. These requests must be submitted within 30 days of the date of this notice to WQM Program Docket at the Department address cited above. If a public hearing for the amendment is held, the public comment period in this notice shall be extended to close 15 days after the public hearing.
