The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Sustainable Waste Management is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Monmouth County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) received by the Department February 1, 2024. This request for Plan Inclusion is for the following: adding lamps, batteries, and solar panels to the list of acceptable items at the Monmouth Wire & Computer Recycling Class D Facility, located at 3250 Shafto Road, Block 145, Lot 14.01 in the Borough of Tinton Falls and updating the facility operating hours to 7:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 7:00 a.m.- 12:00 p.m. on Saturday. There will be no additional operational changes at this facility as part of this plan inclusion.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b), the application to amend the County Plan can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the Monmouth Wire & Computer Recycling Class D Facility is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)31. Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a modification to the Monmouth Wire & Computer Recycling Class D Facility for name for the above noted change.
