The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Sustainable Waste Management is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Cape May County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated March 8, 2024. This Plan Inclusion is to incorporate Cape Mining & Recycling, LLC Class B Recycling Facility into the Cape May County Solid Waste Management Plan. The facility is located at 496 Shunpike Road, Block 410.01, Lots 99.01 & 99.02 in Lower Township. The facility operates Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturday. The Recycling center accepts and processes up to 600 tons of concrete/asphalt per day. Cape May County Municipal Utility Authority is also requesting the removal of Garden State Dredging, Inc. Class B Facility, which occupied the same lot and block within the township, from the County Plan.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the application to amend the Cape May County Solid Waste Management Plan can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the addition of Cape Mining and Recycling, LLC to the Cape May County Solid Waste Management Plan & removal of Garden State Dredging, Inc. from the County Plan is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11.
