The Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Program is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Cape May County Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated September 10, 2012. The September 10, 2012 request for administrative action proposes County Plan inclusion of expanding the lists of "designated" and "recommended" recyclables as well as the modification of the existing Cape May County Intermediate Processing Facility to accept and process both dual stream and single stream materials.

The "designated" recyclable list will now include #3 through #7 plastic bottles, chipboard, and non-bottle rigid plastics five gallons in size or less. The "recommended" recyclable list will now include all hard plastics over five gallons in size (except for PVC pipe and vinyl siding that contains hazardous products), and clear, white and blue shrink-wrap and greenhouse film.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 5 & 6, the modifications of a recycling program and recycling facility constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
