The Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Program is in receipt of the September 30, 2010 request for an administrative action to delete from the Cape May County Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority Class B recycling facility located at Block 410.01, Lot 46.02 in Lower Township. On June 12, 2001, the Cape May County Board of Chosen Freeholders adopted an amendment to their County Plan to include the Lower Township Municipal Authority Class B and Class C recycling facility located on Block 410.01, Lot 59.01 in Lower Township, Cape May County. This amendment was certified as approved with modification by the Department on October 11, 2001.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 7., the deletion of any facility included in the County Plan for more than two years but for which a complete permit application has not been made, or which has not been in operation for more than two years constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
