Dear Mr. Chapman:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Program is in receipt of the December 13, 2006 request for an administrative action. This administrative action proposes to include a leaf composting facility at the site of the Pennsville Township landfill located at Block 4801, Lot 5 in Pennsville Township in connection with the closure of this landfill. Pennsville Township intends on utilizing a portion of the landfill for limited recycling/composting activities upon implementing the landfill closure plan. The recycling activities would include temporarily storing tree branches, tree limbs, tree trunks, brush and wood chips derived from tree parts, leaves and yard trimmings to be received, stored and processed.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b) 3., the inclusion of new recycling facilities for processing Class A or Class C recyclable material constitutes an approvable administration action. Therefore, this request is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
