Your facility is currently authorized under the Hot Mix Asphalt Producers Industry Specific General Permit (NJ0132721). This general permit expires on April 30, 2009. Your facility is not required to reapply for authorization. Your authorization will be automatically renewed after the Department renews the Hot Mix Asphalt Producers Master General Permit.

Enclosed is the draft permit package consisting of the *Public Notice*, Fact Sheet and the proposed renewal Hot Mix Asphalt Producers Industry Specific General Permit (NJ0132721) issued in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A. The *Public Notice* will appear in the *Asbury Park Press*, *Trenton Times*, the *Newark Star Ledger* and in the March 25, 2009 issue of the *DEP Bulletin*.

The public comment period will end on April 23, 2009. The procedures for submitting comments or requesting a public hearing on this draft permit are detailed in the enclosed public notice.
